TO THE BIBLE - Acts 10:38 NKJV

"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

LET'S TALK



A small flame in the middle of a vast, dark auditorium may seem insignificant at first glance. Yet, as your eyes adjust, you realise something profound: that one flame is enough to conquer the shadows. It changes the atmosphere, shifting the focus from darkness to light. Beloved, that is exactly how the Spirit of God describes you.

Jesus declared, *"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden"* (Matthew 5:14 NKJV). You're not an accident in this world. You were born with divine intent—to radiate God's glory, inspire hope, and manifest His goodness. Your presence in any environment should bring illumination, direction, and life.

Think of Jesus Himself. His public ministry was brief—just over three years—but the impact is eternal. What was His secret? Acts 10:38 NKJV reveals it: *"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power..."* That same anointing is upon you today through the indwelling Spirit. You're not ordinary; you're God's answer to your generation.

The Apostle Paul reminds us, *"For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind"* (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV). Fear, timidity, or failure cannot define you because the Spirit within you produces boldness, wisdom, and excellence. In fact, the Bible declares in 1 John 2:20 KJV, *"But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye*

know all things.” That means you have divine insight, supernatural ability, and the wisdom to influence your world.

Therefore, never see yourself as ordinary. Carry this consciousness everywhere: you’re anointed to make a difference! Like that candle in the auditorium, your light can’t be hidden. Shine in your family, your school, your community, and your nation. Let men see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

TO THE BIBLE - Colossians 1:27 NKJV

"To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

LET'S TALK



When the morning sun rises after a long night, its golden rays don't just light up the sky; they transform the atmosphere, dispelling shadows and announcing a brand-new day. In the same way, the revelation of Christ in you lights up your life. It changes everything—bringing glory, beauty, and divine possibilities into your world.

The greatest revelation of the New Testament isn't only that Jesus died for us but that He rose again and now lives in us! This was the mystery hidden for ages but is now unveiled: "Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27 NKJV). Notice, it doesn't say the promise of glory, but the hope of glory—a present-hour reality. The glory is here. The glory is now.

Many quote, "God will not share His glory with another," and that's true when it comes to idols. But with us, He went beyond sharing—He imparted His very glory! The Lord Jesus prayed, *"And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one"* (John 17:22 NKJV). Child of God, when you received Christ, you received glory. Shame and reproach were terminated. You were ushered into the realm of excellence, beauty, and victory.

Romans 3:23 declares that all had sinned and fallen

short of the glory of God. But that was before Christ. Now, with Christ in you, you're not falling short—you're full of His presence, power, and righteousness. You're a God-carrier, the living temple of the Holy Spirit. Everywhere you go, divinity shows up in you and through you. That's why you can never be disadvantaged—the One who created the universe lives in you in His fullness.

More so, you're the glory of God. In Ephesians 1:17 NKJV, He's called, "...the Father of glory..." And if He is the Father of glory, then you—His child—are the glory. This is your identity. See yourself in that glory. Walk in it. Talk it. Live it. The glory life is yours—today and always!

LET'S TALK



In the world of technology, voice commands have changed how we interact with devices. With just a spoken word, doors unlock, lights turn on, and entire systems respond. It's fascinating how much power has been placed in the simple act of speaking. Yet, long before these advancements, God revealed a far greater truth: your words are instruments of creation and change.

As a child of God, it makes no difference what challenges you face—they're bread for you! You're a victor, not a victim. Our opening scripture declares, *"You will also declare a thing, and it will be established for you"* (Job 22:28 NKJV). That's divine authority! Your mouth is the tool for shaping circumstances and enforcing kingdom realities.

Faith doesn't wait for visible results before speaking. Abraham was called "the father of many nations" even before Isaac was born. He declared what God said until it became his reality. Likewise, don't wait for things to change before speaking differently. Don't wait to feel blessed—declare, *"I am blessed!"* For the Word affirms, *"He has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in Christ"* (Ephesians 1:3 NIV).

Keep declaring your health, your progress, your peace. Speak to your body, your finances, and every situation around you. The more you affirm the Word, the more heaven's realities are established in your life. Remember, even salvation is activated by words (Romans 10:9–10).

Every time you speak in line with the Word, you give

divine substance to the unseen. Refuse to stay silent. Keep prophesying your destiny: *"My life is upward and forward! I am excellent and full of glory!"* If you've been in and out of sicknesses, declare divine health and stick to the Word. Soon enough, your entire being will conform to your faith-filled declarations, keeping your body in health always.

Through the Holy Spirit, we know the things freely given to us by God, and we speak them forth (1 Corinthians 2:12–13). Keep talking! Keep declaring your victory. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE Romans 10:6 NIV

"But the righteousness that is by faith says..."

LET'S TALK



Notice how a child naturally imitates the language of their parents. They pick up the accent, the tone, and even the expressions without trying. Why? Because it's their nature to echo what they hear at home. In the same way, when you received the life of God at the new birth, you received His righteousness—and with it, His vocabulary. Now, you don't talk like the world. You speak the language of your Father: the language of victory, dominion, and faith!

The Bible says, "The righteousness which is of faith speaketh..." (Romans 10:6). Righteousness has a voice, and it declares what God has said. When you affirm, "*I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus*" (2 Corinthians 5:21), it's not a mere positive confession. It's truth released into your world! You're saying what God has said. Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV declares, "*...For He Himself has said... So we may boldly say...*"

Your inheritance in Christ is activated by words. The Lord Jesus Himself said you shall have whatsoever you say (Mark 11:23). You can't reign in life unless you talk as the royalty that you are. Your righteousness empowers your speech to produce divine results. Refuse to speak defeat, lack, or fear. Instead, let your words align with God's Word: "*I walk in divine health. I'm marvellously helped of the Lord. My life is upward and forward only!*"

The righteousness of faith calls things that are not as though they were; it speaks reality, and the Word of God is the reality. When you speak the Word of God in faith, you align your life with heaven's will. You silence doubt and confusion. You activate angels. You chart a course of divine success. So, speak boldly. Declare your health, peace, prosperity and victory. Express your righteousness through your words.

"And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son."

LET'S TALK



Once witnessed a police officer who walked into a tense situation with nothing but his uniform and badge. Instantly, people calmed down. Why? It wasn't about his size, his tone, or even his words. It was the authority behind that badge. Everyone recognised it. That's exactly what the Name of Jesus is to you—it's more than a word or phrase; it's your badge of authority in this world and beyond.

The Name of Jesus represents everything He is and everything He accomplished through His death, burial, and resurrection. When you declare that Name, it's as though Jesus Himself is speaking. Philippians 2:9-11 NKJV tells us, *"...God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."* Hallelujah!

This isn't just a beautiful scripture; it's our reality. The Lord Jesus gave us the legal right to use His Name. He said in Mark 16:17-18 NKJV, *"And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."* The

power is not in how loud you speak, but in the authority of the Name.

Peter understood this when he said to the lame man at the Gate called Beautiful, *"In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk"* (Acts 3:6 NKJV). Immediately, strength came to the man's feet and anklebones, and he was healed instantly.

That's the power of the Name in action. Use the Name of Jesus. Use it to reign over circumstances, keep yourself in divine health, and maintain the triumphant life God has given you. Colossians 3:17 NKJV says: *"And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus..."*

LET'S TALK

A world-renowned artist once said, "The greatest tragedy is not in failing to paint a masterpiece, but in never discovering the canvas you were created to paint on." How true this is of life! Many people drift through existence, chasing shadows and pursuing ambitions that were never theirs in the first place. Yet, as God's child, you're not called to guess your way through life. You were created to live in the very centre of God's purpose—flourishing in His divine plan for you.

The Scriptures reveal that you were predestined to a glorious life in Christ: *"For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son"* (Romans 8:29 NKJV). God designed you for alignment with His will, to express His glory, and to manifest His excellence in everything you do.

Ephesians 2:10 (AMPC) makes it clearer: *"For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus...that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us."* Isn't that beautiful? There's a life already mapped out for you—a life of victory, prosperity, health, righteousness, and impact. This is the "good life" that Christ purchased for you.

Like Epaphras, who laboured in prayer for the Colossians, the Spirit of God continually draws you to not

only know but also to stand perfect and complete in the will of God. How? By meditating on the Word and fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit. As you do, your spirit is synchronised with God's thoughts. Through the Word of God and the ministry of the Holy Spirit, you're trained to know and walk in God's divine provisions; your discernment sharpens, and your decisions reflect heaven's interests and intent.

Even now, declare that you're perfect and complete in all the will of God. This is your testimony! You're not ordinary; you're God's workmanship, fashioned for excellence, designed to reign, and ordained to walk in the very paths He has prepared.

LET'S TALK

Some years ago, engineers tested a bridge built to withstand earthquakes. They shook it, strained it, and even tried to break it with simulated tremors. Yet, each time, it stood firm because it wasn't designed to collapse—it was built to endure. That bridge reminds me of the Church of Jesus Christ. The storms of life may rage, opposition may rise, but the Church cannot be destroyed. Why? Because it is built by the Master Builder Himself—our Lord Jesus Christ.

He boldly declared, *"...I will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it"* (Matthew 16:18 KJV). What He builds is eternal, powerful and glorious. And the beautiful thing is this—you're not a spectator in this divine edifice. The Bible calls you "a living stone" (1 Peter 2:5), carefully chosen, shaped, and placed by God to reflect His glory. 

SEEDS

Did you know that life, growth, and faith are often described in the Bible using seeds? From the very beginning, in Genesis 1:29, God said: *"I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth..."* Seeds were not just food; they were symbols of blessing, future, and potential.


A seed is small—sometimes barely visible in your hand—but hidden inside is the blueprint for a tree, a harvest, or even a forest! The Lord Jesus drew on this truth when He said: "The kingdom of God is like a mustard seed, which is the smallest of all seeds on earth. Yet when planted, it grows and becomes the largest of all garden plants" (Mark 4:31–32).

Seeds in Scripture often represent the **Word of God**. Just as a farmer sows seed into the ground, God's Word is sown into our hearts (Luke 8:11). The condition of the soil—our hearts—determines whether the seed grows or withers. Good soil produces fruit, just like a heart open to God's Word brings lasting change.

But seeds also carry another lesson: **multiplication**. One seed can produce a whole plant, which then produces many more seeds. That's why Paul said, *"Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap*

generously" (2 Corinthians 9:6).

So what can we learn? Never underestimate small beginnings. The tiniest act of obedience, the smallest word of faith, or even a simple prayer can grow into something far beyond what you imagined—because God designed seeds to multiply!

LET'S TALK ▶

A famous jeweller once said that diamonds, though formed deep within the earth, don't truly reveal their beauty until they are cut, polished, and placed in a setting where their brilliance can shine. In the same way, your life in Christ is God's masterpiece—cut, refined, and positioned to radiate His glory to the world. You are not an accident, nor are you a random piece of creation; you are God's display of excellence.

The Bible tells us in 1 Peter 2:9 (AMPC): *"But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."* That means your life ought to be full of testimonies. You were born to shine, to impact your world with the glory of God.

The Lord Jesus said, *"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden"* (Matthew 5:14 NKJV). In John 17:22 NKJV, He declared, *"...the glory which You gave Me I have given them..."* That means glory is your name, your identity, and your nature. Your words, your walk and your results are all meant to glorify God because you're the effulgence of the Father's glory.

Don't accept a life of failure or defeat. That's not your calling. There's no shame or reproach in your life. God ordained your life to be the proof of His grace, love and power. You have a life of excellence, victory, purpose and divine eminence. Hallelujah!

You don't have to struggle to succeed. Excellence, wisdom, and increase flow naturally from the divine life at work in you. Walk in the consciousness of who you are in Christ, and your life will be a testimony of ever-increasing fruitfulness and productivity.

LET'S TALK ▶

A sculptor once looked at a rough block of marble and declared, *"I see an angel inside, and I must set it free."* With each deliberate strike of his chisel, the hidden beauty emerged. The words you speak are just like that sculptor's tools—they shape reality, unlocking the treasures of God already present in your life.

Isn't it amazing that the Lord Jesus said in John 20:21 NKJV, *"...Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."* What a profound truth! He has commissioned you with the same authority with which the Father sent Him. The Father gave Jesus the Spirit without measure, and that same Spirit now dwells in you. That means heaven honours your words spoken in faith!

When you boldly affirm God's Word, something extraordinary happens—heaven responds, angels act, and tangible results follow. Speaking God's Word is not mere recitation; it's declaring divine realities with the authority of the Spirit. Remember Genesis 1:3: "God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light." The Holy Spirit—the power of the Godhead—moved on those words and made them reality.

That same Spirit lives in you! The Lord Jesus said, *"...the Father who dwells in Me does the works"* (John 14:10 NKJV).

Today, that Father—the Holy Spirit—dwells in you. When you speak healing, peace, or provision, the Spirit incubates on your words and brings them to pass.

So don't speak fear, doubt, or the language of the world. Fill your heart with the Word of Christ richly (Colossians 3:16). Let your mouth become an instrument of creative power, shaping life and destiny with words of faith. Speak boldly today, for your words carry the very breadth of God!

"But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?' So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."

LET'S TALK

In one pocket, a farmer kept a handful of seeds, and in the other, he kept a handful of grain. The grain was for his immediate food, but the seeds were never to be eaten—they were to be planted for the future. He said, *"If I eat my seed, my tomorrow dies with it."* How profound! When the Lord commits resources to us, He expects us to prioritise His kingdom by giving of the abundance He's blessed us with; that's where our security is.

The Lord Jesus gave a striking parable in Luke 12:16-21. A rich man, overwhelmed by his abundance, decided to build bigger barns to store his goods. With great confidence in his wealth, he said, *"Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry."* But God called him a fool, for that very night his soul was required of him. His wealth suddenly lost its meaning in the face of eternity. The Lord Jesus concluded, *"So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."* It wasn't wealth itself that was condemned—it was his failure to align his resources with God's Kingdom.

To be rich toward God is to prioritise the Gospel above all else. It is to recognise that everything you have is a tool for His glory. Remember the poor widow in Luke 21:1-4 who gave her two mites? Though small, it was everything she had, and the Lord celebrated her sacrifice.

God wants you prosperous, but prosperity with

Kingdom purpose. Paul, by the Spirit, instructed the rich: *“Tell them to use their money to do good. They should be rich in good works and should give happily to those in need, always being ready to share with others whatever God has given them. By doing this they will be storing up real treasure for themselves in heaven—it is the only safe investment for eternity...”* (1 Timothy 6:18-19 TLB). Your true wealth is measured by how much of your life and resources you’ve sown into the Gospel. So, ask yourself today: Am I rich toward God? As you put His Kingdom first, every other thing will be added unto you (Matthew 6:33). Let your resources and efforts reflect a life rich toward God!

LET'S TALK ▶

In ancient cities, a watchman on the wall was vital. His duty was to stay alert, to guard, and to warn. If he forgot his role, the entire city was at risk. Likewise, when we forget our spiritual priorities, we leave room for distractions and worldly influences to creep in.

The early Church spread with astonishing speed; in just three centuries, Christianity had permeated the known world. By 324 AD, persecution was abolished under Emperor Constantine, and within a few short years, Christianity became the official religion of the empire. Yet, in the midst of that success, urgency waned. The Church thought, *"Everyone's religious now; everything is fine."* But Jesus didn't come to start a religion; He came to save men's souls.

The children of Israel made the same mistake. God gave them rest and peace in the land He promised (Joshua 21:43-45). Yet, He warned them not to mingle with other nations or serve their gods (Joshua 23:7-8). Sadly, over time, they forgot and turned to idols. For young people today, the "distractions" may not be pagan idols but things like endless scrolling on social media, chasing popularity, gaming marathons, or relationships that weaken your fire for God. Before long, fellowship fades, church attendance

drops, and soul winning gets pushed aside.

But hear this: you're first and foremost a Christian! Your identity in Christ must be evident in all you do. Don't let social media or the glitter of trends pull you away from your devotion to the Lord. Keep your fellowship strong, your priorities right, and your passion for soul winning alive. Let nothing distract you. Keep your eyes on the Master's call, for that's where true fulfilment lies.

LET'S TALK

A fascinating truth about the eagle is that it never flaps its wings endlessly in flight. Instead, it soars, riding on the currents of the wind. Its strength is not in constant striving but in aligning with the unseen forces that carry it higher. That's how God designed us to live—not by mere struggle on the outside, but by drawing strength from within, where His Spirit dwells.

Ecclesiastes 3:11 NKJV tells us something remarkable: *"He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, He has put eternity in their hearts..."* What a glorious thought! The world is in your heart. Eternity is in your heart. Imagine that! No wonder Jesus said, *"A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things..."* (Matthew 12:35 NKJV).

You carry divine treasures within you. Not only are the world and eternity in your heart, but the very Spirit of God resides there (1 Corinthians 3:16). That's why the Christian life is lived from the inside out. Paul, writing by the Spirit, tells us, *"...though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day"* (2 Corinthians 4:16 NKJV).

The forces that determine your success, health, and victory are not external—they're in your inward man. Proverbs 4:23 exhorts us to guard our hearts diligently, for out of them flow the issues of life. When your spirit is trained

to listen to God, you'll always know what to do, where to go, and how to respond. Living from your spirit means speaking from your spirit. Declare the Word boldly, pray in tongues, and meditate on the Scriptures. Learn to pause and check within before making decisions. As you do, you'll discover that your life aligns perfectly with God's will.

Today, refuse to be driven by circumstances or emotions. Instead, be led by the Spirit within you. That's the secret to consistent victory.

LET'S TALK

Contrary to popular thought, this is not about telling secrets of people's lives—that's prophecy. The gift of knowledge, however, is far more expansive. The word *"knowledge"* here comes from the Greek *"gnosis"*, meaning scientific or intellectual knowledge. This gift allows the Spirit of God to supernaturally impart understanding about divine things, the cosmos, and even practical fields such as medicine, law, engineering, or artificial intelligence. How powerful this is!

Think about it: the One who created the heavens and the earth, the plants, animals, and minerals, can teach you about them supernaturally. He can reveal solutions the world is desperately searching for through you. That's why you must become more conscious of His ministry in your life.

Christ, the embodiment of wisdom and knowledge,

lives in you. The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of knowledge Himself, dwells in you. He's able to transmit divine insight to your spirit, enabling you to walk in higher dimensions of creativity and excellence. Be mindful of His power and presence. As you yield yourself to Him, you'll not only receive answers but also become the answer the world is waiting for.

TO THE BIBLE - 2 Peter 3:18 NKJV

"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen."

LET'S TALK



When a child is born, everything is done for them—feeding, carrying, cleaning, and protecting. The parents don't expect the infant to walk or reason as an adult. But as the child grows, responsibilities are gradually introduced. Imagine if a 15-year-old still expects to be spoon-fed like a toddler—it would be a tragedy! Growth demands change, and responsibility comes with maturity.

In the same way, when you first received Christ, your prayers were often answered quickly—even when they weren't prayed correctly. That was God's way of accommodating your spiritual infancy. Just as parents indulge little children while they're learning, God gave you room to grow.

But as the Bible says, *"For everyone who continues to feed on milk is obviously inexperienced and unskilled in the doctrine of righteousness (of conformity to the divine will in purpose, thought, and action), for he is a mere infant [not able to talk yet]!"* (Hebrews 5:13 AMPC). The Lord expects you to move beyond milk to strong meat. This means your words, your thoughts, and even the way you pray now carry weight. You're no longer to pray randomly or emotionally, but with accuracy and understanding.

For example, we don't pray to Jesus in the Name of Jesus. Scripture teaches us to pray to the Father in the Name of Jesus. When you were born again, you already came to

Him; you're no longer "coming to Him" with every prayer—you now live in Him! These distinctions may not matter to babes in Christ, but they're of great spiritual significance for the mature.

The Bible further declares, *"But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil"* (Hebrews 5:14 KJV). As you apply the Word rightly, you'll rise above the cycle of ups and downs. Instead, your life will move consistently—from faith to faith, grace to grace, and glory to glory. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 1:13 NKJV

"In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise."

LET'S TALK ▶

An artist's signature on a masterpiece declares, "This is mine, authentic, and complete." Likewise, when you received Christ, God placed His divine signature upon you—the seal of the Holy Spirit. What a reality! You're God's treasured possession, distinguished and set apart for glory.

The Scriptures declare, *"...in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise"* (Ephesians 1:13 NKJV). This seal isn't merely a token of identity; it's heaven's declaration of ownership, protection, and inheritance. In ancient times, kings sealed decrees to confirm their authenticity and authority. God has done the same with you—placing His Spirit in you as proof that you're fully His and backed by all of heaven's resources.

When you received the Holy Spirit, you received the *"earnest of our inheritance"*—the guarantee of everything that belongs to Christ (Ephesians 1:14). Since God gave you His Spirit, He already gave you His best. There's nothing greater He could withhold from you. Refuse to walk through life seeking acceptance or trying to qualify for blessings—you're already accepted in the beloved, already qualified, already sealed!

The Holy Spirit in you is your access to divine wisdom, power, and fellowship with the Father. He's your Helper, Teacher, Advocate, Strengthener, Intercessor, Standby, and Guide. TO THE BIBLE Psalm 16:10

"For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption."

LET'S TALK ▶

Builders don't just start laying bricks without a plan; they work with blueprints. Every detail of a house—its foundation, walls, and roof—is drawn out before construction begins. In the same way, Jesus' birth, death, resurrection, and ascension were part of God's divine "blueprint," revealed through prophecy long before they happened. Everything about the Lord Jesus was prophesied ahead of time: His birth, His life, His death, His burial, resurrection, and His glorious ascension to heaven. No wonder He said, "... Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God" (Hebrews 10:7). His crucifixion, for example, was prophesied a thousand years beforehand.

The psalmist gave such a beautiful description of it in Psalm 22 (read the entire reference). Furthermore, Psalm 16:10 tells us about His resurrection, saying, *"For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption."* When Jesus died on the Cross, He went to hell because every sinner who died was supposed to go to hell, and Jesus bore the sins of the whole world. However, in hell, He defeated the devil and the demons of darkness and came triumphantly back to life. Jonah's experience also foreshadowed His resurrection. Jonah 1:17 says, "... And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights."

The Lord Jesus referenced this in Matthew 12:40 NIV, declaring, *"For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three*

days and three nights in the heart of the earth.” Psalm 110:1 is prophetic of His exaltation; it says, “The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.” The Lord Jesus affirmed that this prophecy referred to Himself: “While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The Son of David. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?” (Matthew 22:41-45).

These prophecies and their fulfilment are essential to understanding the things Jesus said about His death and resurrection. They authenticate the truth that He’s indeed the Son of God—God in human flesh—as Romans 1:4 tells us. It says Jesus is declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead. Blessed be God!

LET'S TALK



Think about a student walking into an exam hall with the exam questions already explained to them by the teacher beforehand. While others may be anxious, that student sits confidently, knowing they already have the answers. That's how David faced Goliath. He wasn't intimidated by the giant's threats because he knew he had God's covenant and backing.

This mindset was what set David apart in his day when he confronted Goliath. David heard the same threats from Goliath as the entire Israelite army, but he focused on the fact that he was circumcised and Goliath wasn't. Circumcision was the sign of the covenant between God and Abraham. If you were part of that covenant, it meant you were connected to God. If you weren't circumcised, you had no power against those who were.

David's confidence came from this understanding. He said, *"...who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?"* (1 Samuel 17:26 NKJV). To David, Goliath was no match because Israel was connected to the God of Abraham. This is a powerful lesson for us as God's children. We're not ordinary people. Anyone who's against us is ultimately against God. This might sound overwhelming, but it's the truth. Jesus emphasized this in Acts 9:4 when Saul was persecuting the Church. The Lord said to him, *"...Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?"* Then in our opening verse, we read where He said, *"...and lo, I am*

with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen" (Matthew 28:20 NKJV). When He said this, He meant you have my presence, and you have my support.

How could you be defeated when you have His presence and His support? To have His support means you're backed by all the arsenal and resources of heaven. His entire wealth, all His glory and power, and His angels are available to you. This assurance is not just a comforting thought but a reality that empowers us to live boldly for Him and in defence of the Gospel. With His presence and support, you're unstoppable. Just as David stood confidently against Goliath, knowing he was backed by the living God, you too can stand firm in the knowledge that God isn't only with you, He's in you by His Spirit, in His fullness. Therefore, no adversary or adversity can prevail against you because you're connected to Him. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - John 14:13-14

"And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it."

LET'S TALK



A student carrying a school ID card has access to the library, labs, and even exams, not because of their own name but because the school recognizes the authority behind that card. In the same way, when we pray in the Name of Jesus, heaven responds not because of our own merit, but because of the authority and power vested in His Name. The Name of Jesus holds unparalleled significance. So, understanding the power behind His matchless Name is crucial for every Christian.

In Colossians 1:16-19, the Apostle Paul emphasizes the pre-eminence of the Lord Jesus: *"For by Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him, and for Him: and He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fullness dwell."* Observe that it says, "All things were created by Him and for Him—Jesus." This means that everything in existence, whether visible or invisible, whether thrones, dominions, principalities, or powers, owes its existence to the Lord Jesus.

Also, Ephesians 1:21 (AMPC) unequivocally declares

that the Lord Jesus is *“far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named [above every title that can be conferred], not only in this age and in this world, but also in the age and the world which are to come.”* Therefore, praying in the Name of Jesus is not a religious formality; it’s a privilege, an honour beyond description.

His Name is the greatest Name in heaven, on earth, and under the earth. The Bible tells us in Philippians 2:9-10, *“Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow...”* Using the Name of Jesus in prayer means you have access to all that He is and all that He has. It means you’re operating with His authority and divine power. When you pray in His Name, you’re aligning yourself with the One who created all things and holds all things together. Hallelujah!

LET'S TALK ▶

As Christians, when we say Jesus Christ is Lord of our lives, it means more than Him being our saviour. The Hebrew and Greek words for "Lord" carry the same meaning, which includes master, caretaker, bread provider, sustainer, boss, and teacher. This is the essence of what it means for Jesus to be Lord; it means He's your sustainer, your master, your caretaker, your bread provider, and your teacher. If this is true, and thank God it is, then it means He's more than capable of taking care of you. You don't have to beg Him to take care of you or plead with Him to provide your needs with a sense of desperation as if He's reluctant to do so. Such a disposition reflects a lack of understanding of who Jesus is as your Lord and Sustainer.

Read His words in Matthew 7:11, *"If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?"* Ponder this for a moment. You have to learn to trust the Lord and rely solely on His Word. Act on His Word. The world's systems are failing. In the days of Joseph, the Bible records that money failed. Inflation was rampant and the currency became worthless. But in the midst of that crisis, God's people experienced supernatural prosperity. Why? Their trust was in the Lord, their sustainer.

The Lord Jesus is more than able to sustain you through every season of life. Read Matthew 6:25-34 where He stresses your value and then tells you what to do and what not to do. So, act on His Word today. The triumphant life is for those who act on God's Word.



“PHARMAKEIA”

The Greek word *pharmakeia* is where the English words *pharmacy* and *pharmaceuticals* are derived. In the New Testament, however, it doesn't simply mean the dispensing of medicine. It is used in a deeper, more spiritual sense.

Pharmakeia appears in Galatians 5:20, where Paul lists the *“works of the flesh” that war against the Spirit: “idolatry, witchcraft (pharmakeia), hatred, variance...”* The King James translates it as *witchcraft*, while other versions render it *sorcery*. At its root, *pharmakeia* refers to the use of potions, enchantments, and substances as instruments of manipulation, deception, or control.

In biblical times, it was common for pagan priests and sorcerers to employ mixtures, charms, or “drugs” in rituals. These weren't simply medicinal; they were tied to demonic influence, idolatry, and spiritual bondage. Thus, *pharmakeia* came to symbolize not only physical concoctions but also the systems of manipulation—spiritual or natural—that enslave minds and destinies.

Revelation 18:23 NKJV echoes this when it says of Babylon: *“...for your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery (pharmakeia) all the nations were deceived.”* Notice the connection: entire nations deceived through *pharmakeia*. This shows us that *pharmakeia* is more than a personal sin; it can be a tool of global deception, controlling masses through lies, systems, or even substances.

The lesson here is profound: God wants His children to discern the influences that seek to manipulate their thoughts, choices, and futures. *Pharmakeia* warns us about the subtle operations of darkness that come clothed as “solutions” but are really chains of deception.



i-testify!

As a teenager in Fiji, I struggled with peer pressure. Most of my friends thought it was “cool” to skip classes, party late, and even experiment with things I knew weren’t right. I didn’t want to be left out, so I often went along, even though I felt guilty inside.

Everything changed when I started studying Teevo more seriously. One devotional I read was about “Choosing the Right Friends.” Pastor explained that when you walk with the wise, you become wise, but when you keep company with the wrong people, it destroys your future (Proverbs 13:20). That scripture struck me like never before.

I realised I couldn’t keep following the crowd and still live the life God planned for me. So, I prayed for courage, started speaking God’s Word over myself, and slowly distanced myself from those influences. It wasn’t easy, but the Holy Spirit gave me strength.

Now, I have new friends who love God and encourage me to shine with excellence. I’m more focused in school, active in my church youth group, and full of joy knowing I’m living out God’s purpose for my life.

"There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian band, A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway."

LET'S TALK

The story of Cornelius in Acts 10 beautifully illustrates this truth. Cornelius was a Roman centurion, a Gentile and not part of the Jewish community. Yet, he was a devout man who feared God and was known for his generosity. He gave alms to the people and prayed continually. His giving and prayers did not go unnoticed; they ascended as a memorial before God. As a result of his generosity, God sent an angel to Cornelius with a divine instruction to send for Peter who would bring him the message of salvation. Think about it; an angel appeared to Cornelius because of his giving! God orchestrated an entire salvation plan for Cornelius, his family, and his household because of his generosity. As Peter preached about Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit fell upon everyone present. They began speaking in tongues and praising God. This moment was a pivotal point in the Early Church, highlighting the universal vision of the Gospel. God despises stinginess; it is contrary to His nature and reflects the nature of the devil.

So when God sees a giver, He sees something of Himself in that person and He's drawn to that one in love. 2 Corinthians 9:7 AMPC says, "...God loves (He takes pleasure in, prizes above other things, and is unwilling to abandon

or to do without) a cheerful (joyous, “prompt to do it”) giver [whose heart is in his giving].” Let this be your description and your experience of God’s love will be overwhelming.

TO THE BIBLE - Romans 8:37

"Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us."

LET'S TALK



An athlete signs up for a marathon. On the day of the race, people laugh at him because he looks too small, too unprepared, or not "built" like the others. Some even tell him he should quit before he embarrasses himself. Instead of arguing, he remembers all the early mornings he trained, all the hills he ran, and the strength he built along the way. With that quiet confidence, he runs, and to everyone's surprise, he crosses the finish line first! His victory answers every insult without a single word spoken.

This brings us to a similar story in 1 Samuel 17. The Philistines had gathered a formidable army, and their champion, Goliath, stood defiantly, challenging the Israelites to send out a warrior to face him in single combat. For forty days, Goliath taunted and mocked the Israelite soldiers. The Israelite army found themselves petrified with dread at the thought of confronting Goliath. But in the midst of this dire situation, young David, a stripling, not qualified to be in the army, arrived at the front lines and heard Goliath's taunts echoing in the valley. Incensed by the giant's defiance against Israel and its God, David began to enquire about the situation and what would be done for the man who killed the Philistine champion.

However, David's enquiries were met with skepticism from his oldest brother, Eliab, who questioned his motives. "Why did you come down here?" Eliab demanded. His words dripped with contempt, suggesting that David was merely a shepherd and naive for thinking he could challenge Goliath. Undeterred by Eliab's reproach, David continued to

make enquiries until he was brought before King Saul. There, he confidently recounted his experiences as a shepherd: *"...I've been a shepherd, tending sheep for my father. Whenever a lion or bear came and took a lamb from the flock, I'd go after it, knock it down, and rescue the lamb. If it turned on me, I'd grab it by the throat, wring its neck, and kill it. Lion or bear, it made no difference—I killed it. And I'll do the same to this Philistine pig who is taunting the troops of God-Alive"* (1 Samuel 17:34-36 MSG).

David didn't argue with Eliab or try to prove himself. Instead, he calmly shared his testimony of God's faithfulness. By doing so, he shifted the focus from his brother's cynicism to God's power working through him. Of course, David defeated Goliath, decapitated him, and walked through the streets holding the giant's head. Always remember David's example when doubters and detractors try to talk you down. Stay focused on your calling and your assignment.

TO THE BIBLE - John 1:41-42

"He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messiah, which is, being interpreted, the Christ. And he brought him to Jesus..."

LET'S TALK



Think of a relay race: each runner carries the baton and passes it to the next. If one person decides to stop running or keeps the baton to themselves, the whole team loses. But when each runner faithfully runs their part and passes it on, the team wins together. In the same way, Andrew passed the "baton" of the Good News to Peter, and Philip passed it to Nathanael. Their actions demonstrate a special kind of work—protagonism at its finest.

For example, in John 1:40-42, we see Andrew, one of John the Baptist's disciples who left everything to follow Jesus. Andrew didn't keep this newfound revelation to himself. He immediately found his brother, Simon (Peter), and declared to him, *"We have found the Messiah!"* He then brought Peter to Jesus. Andrew's actions show the heart of a true protagonist—someone who advances and promotes the ministry of Jesus by enlisting others to join His cause and carry out His work. The next day, Jesus called Philip to follow Him. Philip, like Andrew, didn't keep the Good News to himself. He found Nathanael and said, *"...We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph"* (John 1:45). Nathanael, sceptical at first, questioned, *"Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?"* Philip's response was simple, yet powerful; he said to Nathanael, *"Come and see"* (John 1:45-46).

This is the power of protagonism. Andrew and Philip

didn't just follow Jesus; they actively brought others to Him. They connected fellow Jews and devout men who already believed in God to the Messiah's cause. Similarly, in advancing God's Kingdom today, we need a massive army of God's people who are committed, passionate and unrelenting in their dedication to the Gospel. We're in the race for the last lost soul in 2026.

Be a protagonist of this mandate! Enlist and encourage others to join this cause as we fulfil the Great Commission. We must recognize that to effect a change in the world, we require a united army of Christians, each playing their part in advancing the Kingdom of God, especially as the Lord's return is imminent.

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 2:14

"For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us"

LET'S TALK



In a royal family, the servants may live in the palace, but they don't share the king's bloodline. Angels are like those palace servants—glorious, powerful, and always near God—but they're not heirs. You, however, are the king's child, born of His Spirit, sharing His very life and nature. That's why your fellowship is deeper; it's not service from the outside; it's oneness from within. Angels, as far as we know, will live forever. But the life they have isn't eternal life. They don't have the organic and existential attributes of deity. That's why they can't have real fellowship with God.

Only the new creations in Christ are called into fellowship with divinity: *"God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord"* (1 Corinthians 1:9). Do you see why we're different from angels? We were brought into fellowship with Jesus Christ. We've become associates or sharers of His life, glory and nature. In fact, the Bible tells us He brought us into such a relationship that made us joint heirs with Him (Romans 8:17). What a blessed reality!

There's something about this fellowship that's extraordinary. It's deeper than being brought into God's class or being made friends with God; it's the most significant aspect of our fellowship with Him and we find it in John 14:10. There, the Lord Jesus was speaking to Philip, one of His disciples, and said, *"Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto*

you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works." If you understand this scripture, everything about your life is settled.

Who was Jesus referring to when He said, "The Father that dwelleth in me"? He was referring to the Holy Spirit. That's the same Holy Spirit that lives in you today; He's the Father that dwells in you. 1 Corinthians 3:16 says, "*Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?*" Now you can understand why the Bible says, "*...truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ*" (1 John 1:3). Our fellowship, our oneness with divinity, is the biggest thing about Christianity. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 5:30

"For we are members of His body, of His flesh, and of His bones "

LET'S TALK

If your eye sees danger, your legs run, and your hands protect. But if the toe is injured, the whole body limps. In the same way, the Church functions best when every part works together, and even the smallest member is vital. We're the body of Christ. We're members of His body, of His flesh, and of His bones. We're intimately connected to Him and to one another. In 1 Corinthians 12:26-27, Paul further explains this unity: *"And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it. Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular."* This means that every Christian has a specific role and function within the body of Christ.

When one part of the body is affected, the entire body feels it. We're not isolated individuals but interconnected members of the same body—Christ's body. Ephesians 1:22-23 reveals the power and authority given to the Church: *"And hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body..."* The Church, being the body of Christ, carries His authority and power on earth.

Ephesians 4:11-12 gives us an insight into how He builds His Church today: *"And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ."* The word "edifying" means "building"; it's the same word the

Lord Jesus used when He said, "...I will build my church..." (Matthew 16:18). Through the fivefold ministry offices and the work of every Christian, He builds His Church. The whole body grows by that which every joint supplies: *"From him the whole body...grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work"* (Ephesians 4:16 NIV).

Each Christian is a specific member of the body—the building. Together, we're building a magnificent structure, the Body of Christ. As we continue to win souls and grow, the Church becomes more beautiful and impactful, reflecting the glory of Christ. This isn't a task for a select few but for every Christian. Each of us has a role to play, even as a teenager, and together, we're building something extraordinary for God's glory.

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 3:20

"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us."

LET'S TALK



Think of electricity in a house. The wires are already carrying power, but if you don't flip the switch, the light won't come on. The power is present, but it needs to be activated. In the same way, the Holy Spirit in you brings the power of God into your life, but the power only works when you acknowledge and declare it. You have eternal life in you, and that life gives you power over sickness, disease and infirmities. You have power to cast out devils, heal sicknesses and cure diseases. You've been empowered to live in victory and unending prosperity.

This power in you is activated by acknowledgement and declaration. If you don't acknowledge it, it can't work. Sometimes, in a bid to sound humble, some people deny what they have. If, maybe, you said to them, "Oh, you really have power," their typical response would be, "I don't have any power; only Jesus has power." But they're wrong. The same Jesus said in Luke 10:19, "*Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.*"

Don't deny what He gave you simply because you think you're being humble. Acknowledge and affirm that Jesus gave you power to do the impossible—power over all things. Think about it: He gave us the Holy Spirit to live in us. What do you think He's doing inside you? Who is the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Trinity, who brings the power of God into your life. Acts 1:8

says, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you..." That means when you received the Holy Spirit, you received power. Observe how Jesus spoke. He said, "For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself" (John 5:26). Some people must have thought He was too proud for saying that, but He was declaring truth.

Doesn't the Bible say, "...as he is, so are we in this world" (1 John 4:17)? Acknowledge and declare that you're full of power. Let it be in the consciousness of your daily language. Like Prophet Micah, declare, "But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD..." (Micah 3:8). That's how you activate spiritual power. Talking this way will kill any tumour or disease that tries to rear its ugly head in your body. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - Isaiah 43:2

"When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee."

LET'S TALK



Your labour in the Lord is not in vain; it is purposeful and eternal. God never promised that everything would be smooth or without challenges. He told us there would be difficulties, trials and adversaries. But in the midst of them all, He assured us of His presence and victory. Recall what we read in our opening scripture: He didn't say there would be no tempest or fire. The promise is not the absence of challenges but the assurance of His presence and protection for you in the midst of adversities. It helps you understand the reason He says, *"Count it all joy when you go through diverse tests"* (James 1:2).

The Bible tells us in Daniel 3 about Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, three young men who stood firm in their faith despite fierce opposition. Their story is often remembered for the fiery furnace and their miraculous deliverance, but there's more to it. Before they were thrown into the flames, they faced condemnation, rejection and false accusations. They endured hatred and opposition simply because they refused to compromise their faith. 2 Corinthians 4:17 says, *"For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory."* So, there are things you'll have to face, go through, stand against and confront for you to live the

godly life that the Lord has given you.

There may be adversaries on every side, but in the midst of them all, you're more than a conqueror. 2 Timothy 3:12 says, "Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution." Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world (1 John 4:4). He assures us in Matthew 28:20 (NIV), "...And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Set your eyes on the future and on His glory. Refuse to be distracted by the temporary challenges. Be confident that no matter what, His Word will prevail in your life, and His glory will always be revealed in and through you.

TO THE BIBLE - Genesis 30:37

"And Jacob took him rods of green poplar, and of the hazel and chesnut tree; and pilled white strakes in them, and made the white appear which was in the rods."

LET'S TALK



Think about an artist with a blank canvas. Before a single brush touches the surface, they already have an image in their mind of what the painting will look like. Every stroke is guided by that vision. In the same way, Jacob placed rods before the flocks, shaping what they produced. Jacob's story in Genesis 30 and 31 is a fascinating demonstration of the power of vision and imagination.

When Jacob agreed to work for Laban, he was promised cattle as wages. However, Laban repeatedly changed the terms and cheated Jacob. But Jacob, through divine wisdom and creative strategy, turned the situation around. Jacob took rods from green poplar, hazel, and chestnut trees and peeled white streaks on them to make the white appear. He placed these rods in the watering troughs where the flocks came to drink. As the animals mated in front of the rods, they produced offspring that were exactly what Jacob desired. Later, Jacob no longer needed the rods. He separated the young, spotted, and speckled animals and set them before the stronger cattle.

By doing this, he created a vision for the flocks, and they produced according to what they saw. Jacob's method was a demonstration of the creative power of vision. He used his imaginative ability to influence the outcome. When the stronger cattle conceived, Jacob placed the rods before their eyes, ensuring they produced strong, desirable offspring. When the cattle were feeble, he did not use the

rods, so the weaker ones belonged to Laban. Over time, Jacob's flocks grew stronger and more abundant, while Laban's remained feeble.

Jacob's success was by divine revelation. In a dream, he saw the rams leaping on the cattle as ringstraked, speckled, and grisled. An angel confirmed this vision, saying, "...Lift your eyes now and see, all the rams which leap on the flocks are streaked, speckled, and gray spotted..." (Genesis 31:12). How important this is! As a teenager, you have the ability to create the future you desire by focusing on what you want to see. Create the vision that you want with your mind. Through the Word and power of the Holy Spirit at work in you, you can create or shape your physical reality. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE - Joshua 6:2

"And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour."

LET'S TALK ▶

A student preparing for final exams may dream of graduating with top honours. That's vision. But unless they create a strategy—like setting a study timetable, joining group discussions, and practising past questions—the vision will never materialize. Vision inspires, but strategy executes. It's important to understand the necessity of having a strategy. Many of God's children, though able to visualize, lack the vital element of strategy.

Joshua 6 provides a remarkable example of how vision and strategy work together to produce divine results. God said to Joshua, "See, I have given into thine hand Jericho." The battle had not yet begun, but God declared the victory. Joshua had to see it first—this is the power of vision, seeing what God has already given you and acting accordingly. However, vision alone is not enough. God gave Joshua the vision, but Joshua needed a strategy to take the city. The divine strategy was for him and the children of Israel to march around Jericho for seven days. Joshua had to follow the strategy to bring the vision to pass. In the same way, when God gives you a vision, He also gives you the strategy to accomplish it. Be sure to employ that strategy.

Life is a construction, not an accident. If life were an accident, it would be chaotic. Many people live in chaos

because they have not structured their lives with purpose and vision. They drift from one event to another, relying on luck or chance. But a successful life or any successful endeavour is built on a solid foundation through vision, strategy, principles and means. It makes no difference what your endeavour is; function from where God has positioned you, and use the tools He has given you—vision, strategy, and faith—to build something extraordinary.

TO THE BIBLE - 2 Chronicles 14:11

"And Asa cried unto the LORD his God, and said...help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee, and in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou art our God; let not man prevail against thee."

LET'S TALK



There's a remarkable story of war in the days of Asa, king of Judah. The Bible tells us in 2 Chronicles 14:9 that Zerah the Ethiopian came against Judah with an army of a million men and three hundred chariots. That was an overwhelming force. But Asa didn't cower in fear; instead, he went out to face them, setting the battle in array in the valley of Zephathah at Mareshah. Then Asa did something inspiring; he cried unto the Lord his God for help!

Though vastly outnumbered, he knew he needed a miracle, and his trust was in the Lord. He recognized that numbers meant nothing to God. His confidence was in the Name of the Lord. He said, *"...in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou art our God; let not man prevail against thee"* (2 Chronicles 14:11). What an audacity of faith! Asa understood that life is controlled from the spiritual realm, so he looked beyond the physical advantage of the enemy and saw the Lord as his help. This is the mindset you must have at all times. No matter the opposition, the power, influence, or wickedness of the adversary, greater is He that is in you than Satan and his cohorts put together. They may appear formidable, but they are weak, and you're strong. Their words are empty, but yours are full of divine authority.

The result of Asa's prayer was extraordinary. The Bible says, "...the LORD smote the Ethiopians before Asa, and before Judah; and the Ethiopians fled" (2 Chronicles 14:12). They fled despite their overwhelming numbers, and Asa and his men pursued them all the way to Gerar, utterly overthrowing them. The Bible says they could not recover themselves because they were destroyed before the Lord and His host. Asa and the people of Judah carried away great spoils (2 Chronicles 14:13). The victory was total; read 2 Chronicles 14:14-15. The fear of the Lord fell upon their enemies, and Judah prospered. Our God is great. So, when you face challenges, don't be moved. Focus on Him. He is your help, and through Him, you always prevail. Hallelujah!
