Jesus promised that He is coming back for everyone who believes in Him. The Bible tells us that one day, we will meet Him in the air (1 Thessalonians 4:16–17). It will happen suddenly, just like when Enoch was taken (Genesis 5:24) and when Elijah was taken up to heaven (2 Kings 2:11).

THE HOLY COMMUNION

1. The Holy Communion was introduced by the Lord Jesus during the Passover meal with His disciples (Matthew 26:26-28; Luke 22:19-20).
2. We take the Holy Communion to remember what Jesus did for us — His death, burial, and His resurrection (Luke 22:19; 1 Corinthians 11:24-26).
3. The bread reminds us of Jesus' body that was given for us (Matthew 26:26; 1 Corinthians 11:24).
4. The cup reminds us of Jesus' blood that was poured out so we could be cleansed from all sin (Matthew 26:28; 1 Corinthians 11:25).
5. The Holy Communion reminds us that

us through the shedding of His blood (Luke 22:20; Hebrews 9:22).

6. When we take the Holy Communion, we're showing that we believe in what Jesus has already done for us (1 Corinthians 11:26; John 19:30).
7. The Holy Communion isn't just a regular meal; it's a special time of fellowship with Jesus (1 Corinthians 10:16).
8. When we take the Holy Communion together, it shows that we're one big family in Christ (1 Corinthians 10:17).
9. The Bible teaches us to take the Holy Communion with understanding and reverence for the Lord (1 Corinthians 11:27-29).
10. The Holy Communion is also referred to as the Lord's Supper (1 Corinthians 11:20).

You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.



As God's child, the Lord has given you something very special—His grace. Grace is God's help working in you and for you, even when things seem difficult.

What You Need To Know About Evangelism

I hope you enjoyed learning from God's Word in our last edition. In this edition, we will learn more about Evangelism. It will be fun and interesting. You'll know what evangelism means and its purpose. Let's begin!

Introduction- Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15; 1 Timothy 2:4

Evangelism means telling someone else the message you believe—the message that changed your life—so it can change their life too.

We often call this “Soul Winning.” But I’ve explained something important before: many people only “save” a soul, but God wants us to also “win” the soul!

So don't stop at just “saving” a soul. You must finish the work by “winning” the soul. The Lord's command in Matthew 28:19-20 teaches us this clearly: *“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.*

We can see that the Lord doesn't want us to only preach or talk to people. He wants us to teach them and help them grow as His followers. It's like when a woman has a baby. The work is not finished after the baby is born. She doesn't leave the baby alone. She takes the baby home and cares for it as it grows.

Titbits

This is the focus of Evangelism today. It's not enough to tell people about Jesus; we must also teach them and help them grow. This is the Lord's command. This is what is happening to you right now!

So, when you start sharing God's message, help the people you reach to connect with our Church near them. This will help them grow, and the work of soul winning can continue.

Purpose For Evangelism—2 Corinthians 5:17-18; 1 Timothy 2:4; John 15:16

Everything God does has a purpose. When you understand why God wants us to win souls, you'll not feel confused or afraid. You'll be sure and ready. When God saves you, He also makes you His helper in bringing others to Him. This is a great honour—to share God's message with others.

In 2 Corinthians 5:17-18, we learn this truth we must believe and live by: *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,"*

God has given us this special work. No person can give it to you. People can give you a job, but only God can give you a ministry. No president or government can choose you for this. Only God can.

That's why you should always be thankful that you have received this Ministry of Reconciliation.

"You're a Minister of Reconciliation." Say it. **"I am a Minister of Reconciliation."**
