TO THE BIBLE - Matthew 28:20

LET'S TALK



Elephant calves in the wild rarely stray far from the herd because they're always aware that the other elephants are nearby. That awareness helps them stay calm, confident, and protected, even in difficult or dangerous places. In the same way, when you become aware of God's presence with you, it can bring a new level of confidence to your life.

When you're conscious of God's divine presence with you, your life will be an unending stream of the miraculous. Dr Daisy Osborn used to say, "Practise the presence of Jesus," and I urge you to do the same. Practising the presence of God means living your life with the consciousness that God lives in you, and He's also with you. Thus, statements such as, "I'm so lonely and alone in this world; nobody understands me at school or online", should be completely banished from your life. Rather, you say, "The Lord is with me always, even in class, at home, and with my friends."

When Jesus said, *"...lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age"* (Matthew 28:20), He wasn't kidding. It makes no difference whether or not you "feel" He is close; He's right there with you and in you! Don't allow your mind to think thoughts of loneliness and weakness; look in the mirror and tell yourself, "God is with me, and He lives in me, even when I feel left out or unsure!"

You must begin to think, talk, and function as though God is with you, because He is! Talk to Him often. Relate with Him like a real Person who can hear and appreciate your

concerns—including school pressure, friendships, and decisions you need to make. When you're conscious of His presence this way, you wouldn't recognise the absence of others or the challenges and adversaries you face. It's something you must practise consciously, especially when you're alone.

If you can be bold in the presence of God when you're alone, you'll win when you come out of your closet. That will be the end of all your struggles. Fear, worry, anxiety, doubt and stress will be gone from your life for good. He'll lead, guide, protect and strengthen you. As He said to Joshua, He says to you today, *"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go"* (Joshua 1:9).

LET'S TALK



Modern aircraft can track their position within metres using satellites thousands of kilometres above the earth. Without that guidance, even the most powerful plane could easily lose its way. In the same way, life without direction leaves many people uncertain about the future.

As one who is born again, never find yourself anxious about the future, especially when it comes to school, career choices, or your purpose in life. The Lord Jesus said, *"When the Holy Spirit, who is truth, comes, he shall guide you into all truth...He will tell you about the future"* (John 16:13 TLB). The man without the Holy Spirit is the one who should be uncertain about his future, for he's like an aeroplane without a pilot, or a ship without a captain, lost at sea, bobbing up and down in the water. Such a person is walking in darkness, without a sense of direction.

But if you're born again, you can be certain that your future is a bright and prosperous one. You don't have to panic about "what's next" or compare your journey with others. Life doesn't have to be mysterious anymore because the Holy Spirit has come to guide you and bring the future into your present. LET'S TALK ►

Just as every device must stay connected to its power source to function, every living system in nature depends on the environment that produced it. Fish survive only in water because their bodies are designed to extract oxygen from it, while land animals rely on air and solid ground for movement and life. When any organism is separated from its natural source, it quickly weakens and dies. This simple principle of life reveals an important spiritual truth.

In the book of Genesis, God said, *"...Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures"* (Genesis 1:20). He spoke to the water to produce fish and other sea creatures. That's why the fish in the sea have to remain in the water to survive, because that's their source. If you were to take a fish out of your aquarium and place it on a beautifully ornamented table, it would die, as it's cut off from its source.

In the same way, God said, *"Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind"; and it was so* (Genesis 1:24). So, all the animals that live on land actually came from the earth and that's why they must remain on land to stay alive. No land animal can successfully live in the water permanently because the land is its source. Man is a spirit, and his spirit came from God, even though

his physical body came from the ground. Any man who is cut off from God, his source, is actually in death. That's why Jesus said that such a one must be born again (John 3:7).

If you're born again, you're born by the Word of God (1 Peter 1:23), therefore you also must remain connected to your source, which is the Word of God, which itself is God (John 1:1). Skipping your Bible study is like letting your spirit starve or leaving your phone on 1% battery; you won't have the strength to function properly. Make a quality decision to remain connected to the Word of God, which is the nourishment you need for a healthy, prosperous, successful and victorious life! Don't just scroll through social media all morning; read and study the Word every day, meditate on it and keep speaking it.

LET'S TALK



High above the earth, strong winds can carry desert dust across entire oceans, sometimes moving tiny particles from the Sahara all the way to the Americas in just a few days. In nature, distance does not always limit influence. Oceans, winds, and migrating animals often connect places that are thousands of kilometres apart. Our world constantly shows that movement and impact are not always limited by physical distance. In much the same way, the Holy Spirit can move through us to accomplish God's purposes beyond the limits of where we stand.

One of the many glorious benefits of having the Holy Spirit live in us is His ability to divinely transport us, such that He can achieve His purposes on the earth through us. In 2 Corinthians 13:14, the Bible says, *"The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen."* The word translated "communion" is from the Greek "koinonia", and it means "communion," "fellowship," "partnership", and also "transportation." So, the Apostle Paul was praying that the church would actively experience that divine transportation.

In these last days, the church is going to witness tremendous levels of "Holy Ghost transportation!" In the Book of Acts, we read of how Philip, a man about God's business, was physically moved by the Holy Ghost. He was with the Ethiopian

eunuch, and suddenly the Spirit of God took Philip away, and the man didn't see him anymore. Such a manifestation is not limited to the pages of the Bible. As you yield to the Spirit and let Him have His way in your life, there's no saying how mightily God would use you.

Beyond being physically moved, you can be divinely transported in the spirit to accomplish divine tasks in other nations. The Holy Spirit doesn't have to move you physically to that place to accomplish His purpose. Right from your bedroom, as you pray in the Spirit, you can impact your school, your city, and even people thousands of miles away! Don't be too tired or distracted by your phone to pray, because the Spirit desires to use you to touch people and places beyond your physical reach.

LET'S TALK



Every day, satellites orbiting the Earth transmit huge amounts of data that help scientists predict storms, guide aircraft, and monitor the planet. Without this information, even the most advanced technology would struggle to work effectively. In many ways, access to the right knowledge determines whether systems succeed or fail. The same principle applies to life.

The knowledge of the Word of God is vital to living a successful and victorious life. Unfortunately, some people inadvertently ignore knowledge, and they're the ones who are called "fools." If you were to ask some teenagers why things aren't working out for them, they'd have all sorts of reasons: "Oh, my teachers are mean," or "I'm from a disadvantaged home", and so on. If you were to ask them, "When last did you study your Bible, or listen to a message?" you're sure to find out that such folks aren't consistent in taking in God's Word. Though they might not know it, they have been ignoring knowledge.

Any person who ignores knowledge is setting up himself for the hard life and that's why the Lord said, *"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge..."* (Hosea 4:6). The reason for the hard life many are facing isn't the lack of prayer or power, but the lack of the knowledge of God's word, which is revelation knowledge. In your life, don't ignore knowledge. If you're that way, God won't give you

more of it. Jesus said, "Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine" (Matthew 7:6); in other words, He will not give precious revelations to the man who despises knowledge.

Go for the knowledge of God's Word with all your heart. If you find that you spend all your free time on social media or gaming at the expense of God's Word, then you're ignoring knowledge. The cost of getting a digital message or a Christian book that'll change your life is a little compared to the everlasting impact it will make in your life. Invest in obtaining materials that have the potential to transform your life forever. Always remember that the knowledge of God's Word is the key.

LET'S TALK



Have you ever met someone who just seems to have it all together? Not in a fake, try-hard way, but they just have this "it" factor. Teachers like them, other kids want to be around them, and opportunities just seem to fall into their lap. They walk into a room, and the whole atmosphere shifts. You might think it's luck or confidence, but the Bible has a name for it: it's called grace.

The word "grace" is from the Greek "Charis" and it refers to the divine influence in a human heart, which reflects on his outside, producing favour, beauty, goodwill, loveliness and ability. In other words, when "grace" is working in your life, there's just something about you that causes favour and glory to abound in your life.

For example, when the Lord Jesus was a child, the Bible says he *"...grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him"* (Luke 2:40). It made Him, even as a child, to have favour with God and man (Luke 2:52). Think about that—even as a kid, Jesus had this grace on His life that made people of all ages like Him and respect Him. In the Book of Acts, Barnabas went to visit certain brethren and *"...when he came and had seen the grace of God, he was glad, and encouraged them all..."* (Acts 11:23). What was it that Barnabas saw? It wasn't a light beaming out of their heads--He saw the beauty of God; he saw that things were working out excellently in the lives of these brethren.

Grace is the power of promotion; it is the thing that causes your life to move from one level to another, and that's why the Bible says we must grow in it. The good news is that every child of God has received grace in abundance (Romans 5:17), but the degree to which you let it reflect is up to you. The more you fill your heart with God's Word and have the Holy Spirit work in your life, the greater that grace will shine forth on the outside.

You can and should increase in that outward reflection of the glory of God in your spirit, to such an extent that others would take notice. They might not be able to explain it, but they will not be able to deny that there's just something excellent and beautiful about you.

TO THE BIBLE - 1 Peter 3:4

"rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God."

LET'S TALK



You know how in video games you usually have an avatar? That character running around, jumping, and exploring is just the skin you control. The real you is the player holding the controller. In the same way, your body is like your earth-suit, your avatar. But the real you? That's the spirit man living inside.

The one Peter calls the "hidden person of the heart" is the same one the Apostle Paul calls the "inward man" (2 Corinthians 4:16). The inward man is the human spirit, the one who can't be seen with the optical eyes. The "outward man" is the body with its five senses. The real "you" is the inward man, not the outward man. When you speak, it's the inward man that talks through your mouth.

You're a spirit being, not a physical body. The body that you see is your house, not the real you (2 Corinthians 5:1). A lot of people get this backwards. They spend all their time and energy worrying about what their "avatar" looks like—their clothes, their skin, their hair—and they forget to upgrade the person inside. It's important to recognise that you're a spirit being, because the man inside is the one that God deals with and relates to, not the physical body. This is the reason the Bible says, *"The spirit of a man is the lamp of the Lord, searching all the inner depths of his heart"*

(Proverbs 20:27).

The Lord relates with your spirit in leading and guiding you, not your mind or your body. The character you exhibit outside is a direct reflection of the state of your spirit, so God contacts you through your spirit. As you walk in this consciousness, you'll live beyond physical circumstances; your body will comply with the inward man, and your life will be supernatural every day.

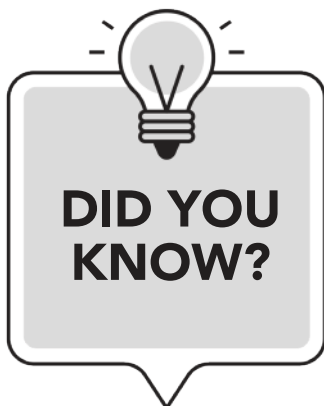

FUN FACTS ABOUT LAUGHTER

Laughter isn't just fun; it's powerful! Proverbs 17:22 says, "*A merry heart does good like medicine.*" When we laugh, our bodies and minds actually benefit in amazing ways. Here are some cool facts about laughter you'll want to know:

1. Your brain releases endorphins when you laugh, which makes you feel happy.
2. Frequent and whole-hearted laughter actually helps your body to fight off harmful diseases. By lowering cortisol levels, laughter reduces stress and helps protect your body from harmful effects. Laughter has been linked with boosts in immune function, pain tolerance, cardiovascular health, and even memory retention.
3. When you laugh, you strengthen muscles in your face, stomach, and diaphragm.
4. For every fifteen minutes of solid full-body laughing you do, you burn up to 50 calories! Combined with exercise, laughing can slightly help burn calories.
5. Humans are not the only beings that laugh. Many animals, including dogs and even some primates, show behaviours similar to laughter.
6. Laughing creates an instant bond between individuals. When you laugh with someone else, you feel a natural connection to that person, and it alleviates the social stress of being around

new people.

7. Just as children laugh more than adults, surveys have shown that ladies tend to laugh slightly more than their male counterparts. Babies laugh about 300 times per day.

8. Laughter really is contagious: Even when we do not see where the source of the laughter is, simply hearing the sound of laughter can cause the hearer to join in.

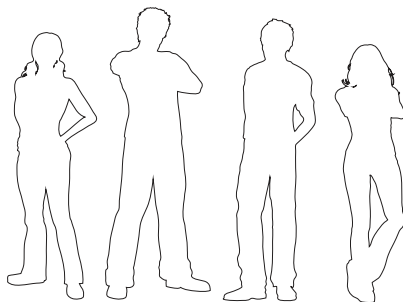
9. A 2002 study in Psychological Reports reveals that forcing yourself to laugh (or even just to smile) can improve your mood. The human brain is not able to distinguish spontaneous laughter from self-induced.

10. Ever run out of breath while laughing? That's your diaphragm spasming, creating the classic "ha-ha" or "he-he" sounds.

11. You can't make yourself laugh by tickling yourself. Why? It's impossible to surprise your brain. Your brain predicts the sensation your fingers will make just before you tickle yourself, so it's not a surprise.

12. Laughter is a universal sound that isn't tied to any specific language.

"If you've been facing trying times, I recommend to you 'laughing sessions.' Laugh your way to victory"—Pastor Chris.

TO THE BIBLE - Romans 12:1

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service."

LET'S TALK



Imagine a friend gave you their brand-new gaming console to borrow for the weekend. You'd treat it with respect, right? You wouldn't spill drinks on it or drive it into a wall. You'd want to take care of it because it's a gift you're responsible for. Well, God has given you a gift too: your body. And He actually lives in it.

The Bible says, *"Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's"* (1 Corinthians 6:19-20). Your body is actually a gift of trust given to you by God to function here on earth, and He expects you to use it wisely, because every one of us will account for what we did with our bodies. This is the reason the Lord tells you to present your body as a living sacrifice.

To present your body as a living sacrifice means that you present your body to the Word of God. In other words, you cause your body to do only those things that the Word of God says you should do. You make your body function in such a way that brings glory to the Word of God. For example, the Bible says you should put to death the illegal transactions of the body (Romans 8:13); so, when your body starts feeling tired, lazy, or tries to get sick right before a big

game or exam, you say, "Body, you're the temple of the Holy Ghost; we're not accommodating sickness or weakness here; I'm alive!"

Again, the Word of God says that "*sin shall not have dominion over you*" (Romans 6:14), and so you let God's Word and righteousness reign in you. When you present your body to the Word of God, life will take on a whole new meaning; sickness and infirmity, depression and sorrow will be a thing of the past! The glory of God will be mightily manifested from your spirit, through your body, to the outside world.

Every ecosystem on earth depends on order. When the seasons run their normal course, crops grow well, rivers flow steadily, and animals can find the food they need to survive. But when that order is disrupted, even strong systems begin to struggle. In the same way, life often produces its best results when we live according to the order established by God.

Everything God created was good and especially made for your comfort and provision. That's why the Word says all things are yours to enjoy! But sadly, some young Christians believe they have to suffer and settle for the lesser things in life. They've been taught that it's wrong to look good, and it's better to be poor on earth and go to heaven than to be rich on earth and go to hell. Being rich and looking good have nothing to do with going to hell or heaven—including enjoying your youth responsibly.

The Bible says in 2 Corinthians 8:9, *"For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich."* Jesus suffered that we might not suffer; He became poor that we might become rich; He brought us out that He might take us in. He tells us in Isaiah 1:19, *"If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land..."*

This means your life becomes enjoyable when you decide to walk in obedience to the will of God.

Obedience is an act of submission to the leadership of God. When you obey God's command, you come under His authority. As such, He's empowered to act on your behalf. But when you disobey, you break His hedge of protection around you, and you give the enemy the chance to strike.

Start from where you are and respond to God's Word today. Be conscious that indeed all things are yours and that He's given you all things that pertain to life and godliness. Walk in obedience so you will enjoy all He has given to you and made available for you. How much you enjoy life depends on you. Start today!

LET'S TALK



Across the world, ecosystems can exist side by side yet function under very different conditions. In the deep ocean, for example, some creatures survive in crushing darkness and extreme cold, while nearer the surface, life thrives in sunlight and warmth. Both environments exist on the same planet, yet the life in one cannot live by the conditions of the other. Similarly, human life can be understood as operating within two distinct spiritual realms.

There are two spiritual realms of life and death existing side by side, and everyone is in either one of them. Everyone who is born into this world is born into the realm of death (separation from God), and in that realm, there is sickness, sin, poverty and every kind of evil. Then, there is a realm of life where God operates, and in this realm, everything is good.

The Bible says God *"has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love"* (Colossians 1:13). The word "conveyed" also means "transferred." When you were born again, you were transferred instantly from the realm of death into the realm of life, and that's where you live now. It's like a permanent "realm shift" where the old laws of failure and depression no longer apply to you.

In the opening Scripture, Jesus said, "He who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting

life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life". He didn't say, *"He shall pass from death to life"*. John said the same thing: *"We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren"* (1 John 3:14).

As long as you're born again, you're not about to be transferred to the realm of life; you're there already. You might sit in the same classroom as everyone else, but you're functioning in a different realm. When you realise that you've passed from death to life, life will take on a new meaning. In the realm of life, there is no sickness, no death, no poverty and any such evil thing. Rather, there's prosperity, life and peace! Everything that you lay your hands upon prospers, and you're a victor every day.

In 2009, an unknown Scottish woman stepped onto a talent show stage and stunned the audience with an extraordinary voice. Within minutes, someone many had overlooked became a global sensation overnight. Moments like that remind us how quickly a person can move from obscurity to the spotlight when the right opportunity appears.

Promotion doesn't come from the east or west, but from God alone. He's the only one who can supernaturally promote you in a way that'll baffle your detractors. The promotion that comes from God is the kind of promotion that defies human logic and leaves people wondering how it happened. The Bible tells us how Joseph was sold into Egypt as a slave by his brothers. To further compound his ordeal, while serving in Potiphar's house, he was falsely accused and imprisoned. Things looked bleak until the Pharaoh had a dream which no one but Joseph could interpret.

After Joseph interpreted the dream and proffered his advice on how to contain the coming famine, the king said, *"Inasmuch as God has shown you all this, there is no one as discerning and wise as you. You shall be over my house, and all my people shall be ruled according to your word; only in regard to the throne will I be greater than you"* (Genesis 41:39-40). Glory to God! Joseph went from prisoner to Prime Minister of a superpower nation in one day! That's

supernatural promotion---the promotion that comes from God.

A few verses before the opening Scripture, the king had been angry with all his wise men and threatened to kill them all. Yet, a little while later, Daniel was promoted! He received both the knowledge and the interpretation of the king's dream and saved his life and the lives of many others. God used a situation that should have led to his destruction as a means of promotion for him!

Get ready to receive inexplicable promotions in school, in leadership roles, and in responsibilities people may think you're "too young" for. This is your season to get promoted to higher levels and positions at work that may not look like they belong to you yet! Challenges will come that only you can solve. All you need to do is be diligent like Joseph and Daniel were, and at the right time, your promotion will come. Praise God!

LET'S TALK



A rechargeable battery may possess the capacity to power a great machine, yet that power remains static and unused until a connection is made. Many systems in the world work the same way: energy must be activated before results can be seen. In the life of a Christian, there's also a divine way to stir up and activate the power within. One of the most powerful ways to do this is by speaking in other tongues.

Speaking in other tongues is one spiritual activity you must take seriously! If you've not been praying this way, you're missing too much! Paul said, *"I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all"* (1 Corinthians 14:18). He could brag about it because he understood the immense benefits of speaking in other tongues. No wonder he had such remarkable results.

Speaking in other tongues is an important way to accomplish a God-given purpose. It's a way to "quick-charge" your spirit and cause you to respond very quickly to spiritual things. As you pray in tongues, the anointing is stirred within you and, suddenly, you're turned into another man.

When you're born again and filled with the Holy Spirit, the power of God comes to reside in you. This power is triggered or set in motion when you speak in other tongues. 1 Corinthians 14:4 says, *"He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself..."* The Greek word translated as "edifies" means "to construct or to build up, to embolden or charge up like a

battery.” The scripture is therefore telling us that the one who speaks in other tongues builds himself up like an edifice; he emboldens himself and charges himself like a battery.

Speaking in tongues is the solution to fear and timidity. If you ever feel nervous speaking up in class, afraid of the future, or unsure of yourself, activate the power within you by speaking in other tongues; you’ll find yourself dealing wisely and soundly in the affairs of life. Also, if you want to operate in the highest level of faith which you’ve attained, then you must consistently speak in other tongues. In Jude 1:20, the Bible says when you speak in other tongues, you’re building yourself on your most holy faith. That means the Spirit of God is able to take God’s Word right into your spirit, where it produces God’s kind of faith.

LET'S TALK



Just as a small battery can power a large machine when connected properly, hidden sources of energy often produce results far greater than their size suggests. In nature, a tiny ant can carry loads many times its own weight because of the strength built into its design. This shows that true capacity is not always determined by outward appearance. In much the same way, there is a remarkable ability at work within you.

You need to know that there's an ability working in you, and that ability is supernatural! It doesn't burn out, and it doesn't need replenishing. That means that feeling tired, overwhelmed, or "not enough" doesn't define your limits. Haven't you read how Samson defeated one thousand trained soldiers of war with the jawbone of a donkey? He could never have done it with his physical ability, no matter how good a fighter he was. The Spirit of God came on him mightily, and he was divinely enabled—he was energised to do superhuman things.

For us, it's even better, because the supplier of that divine energy, the Holy Ghost, lives in us. That means our potentials are limitless! You're not just surviving your day; you're divinely energised for it. Paul knew this for sure; that's why he wrote the words in the opening Scripture for us. He calls it "Christ's mighty energy"; the King James Version of the Bible calls it "his working, which worketh in me mightily." Glory to God! God's supernatural ability works

in you mightily, helping you achieve results that are beyond your physical ability.

The Bible says, *"Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God"* (2 Corinthians 3:5). The word translated "sufficiency" also means "ability." This means there is a divine ability available to you, and that ability is the power of the Holy Ghost at work in you. If you take advantage of this divine ability, it'll make a difference at school and in whatever you do. You'll go further, faster and better than your physical ability can take you.

Across the world, disagreements between people, groups and nations often grow into hostility. History shows how quickly differences can turn individuals into enemies. Many societies even justify loving those who support you and rejecting those who oppose you. Yet the Lord Jesus profoundly challenges this thinking.

The society tells you to love your friends and hate your enemies. On the contrary, the Lord Jesus is teaching you in the portion of the scripture you've just read to love both your friends and enemies. It's important to note that He was addressing men who weren't born again; people who still thought of their enemies as flesh and blood. Sadly, some young people still think this way, and sometimes pray against their classmates or peers, saying, "Oh Lord! Fight against my enemies, destroy them...."

You can't be God-conscious until you're conscious of God's love. This is why you must always take out time to meditate on the love of God. Think about His grace, kindness and how He chose you to be His child, despite your imperfections.

Always remember that if you were the only one on earth, the Lord Jesus would still have given His life for you. Just as the man in Matthew 13:44 sold everything he had to buy a field because of the treasure in it, you're the treasure Jesus saw that He willingly gave His life for. When you let the love of God dominate you as you meditate on His Word, you'll cease to be enemy-conscious.

LET'S TALK



Some runners start a race strong but falter before the finish line. Others stumble at the first sign of resistance. But the one who finishes strong is remembered—not for how fast they ran at the start, but for how they ran when the pressure was greatest.

There's a race of life, and everyone is involved in that race, whether or not they know it. When Paul said, "I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus," the idea most folks get is that of someone inching his way slowly through a press to reach the goal. The Greek word translated "press" is "dioko", and it means "to run swiftly as in a race so as to win a prize."

Not only is it important for you to know that you have a race to run, it is even more important for you to know "how" to run your race. You must run fast, because the time is short and the adversary will do everything to frustrate you from getting the prize. This is why Paul said "I run swiftly toward the mark for the prize."

What's that prize? It's not just talking about heaven; the man wanted to fulfill God's purpose and calling for his life and finish it completely! No wonder at the end of his life, he could boldly declare, *"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness..."* (2 Timothy 4:7-8).

Like the Apostle Paul, run your race with purpose. Think about your school goals, your friendships, or your talents; what has God put in your life that only you can develop? What is that thing God has called you to do? Commit your whole being to it. Let your heart's cry be to fulfil God's purpose and plans for your life. Even small steps count—showing kindness, doing your homework with excellence, standing up for what's right—they're all part of your race! Run your race to win, so that at the end, you too can boldly declare, "I have finished my course, I have kept the faith," and then receive the Master's crown.

LET'S TALK



Most rivers don't create their own water; they simply carry water from a larger source, such as rainfall, glaciers, or lakes. When the source dries up, the river eventually disappears. What many people call their "supply" is often only a channel. The most important thing therefore isn't the channel, but the source of it.

Now, the way some people live, you would think Paul meant, "My God shall supply all your needs according to how much you're paid at your place of work." Even if your "job" is chores, a part-time gig, or allowance, God is still your ultimate source. Your job ceased to be the source of income for you the day you were born again. Now God supplies all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19).

If you look at the Sun you will not see the shadows; in the same way, when you put your trust in God, you will stop chasing shadows. Stop stressing about allowance, online fame, or what your friends have—you have a bigger source. Stop seeing your job or your business as your source of income, for God is your source.

The forces of nature will try to make you believe your job is your source, but refuse it completely. The Bible didn't say "Work, that you may have money." Rather, it tells us that the reason God wants you to work is so that you "may have

to give to him who has need" (Ephesians 4:28). Even small acts, like helping a friend, volunteering, or sharing your lunch, are ways God blesses others through you. Your job is a channel to bless others, and in doing so, you are rewarded. Giving is God's established medium to prosper you financially—never forget it.

Therefore, it doesn't matter how much you're paid at your job or business, never take it as your source of income. Do your schoolwork, sports practice, or any responsibility with excellence and avoid laziness, and God will promote you. Do your job with excellence and shun mediocrity, and the Lord will promote you.

You're meant to tackle every test, every argument, and every challenge at school or home with a mindset of victory. You're supposed to live each and every day of your life in victory over every situation that you face. The day you were born again, you were born into the life of total and continuous victory—you're born to win! The death of Jesus on the Cross and His triumphant resurrection made us one with God and brought us into a life of victory.

The Bible says that God, *"...raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come"* (Ephesians 1:20-21). And that includes YOU, even when life feels like it's stacked against you at school, online, or with friends. The Bible says God, *"...even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ... and raised us up together, and*

made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:5-6). The story doesn't end with Jesus alone; God raised you up together with Him, and you're also seated with Him in glory!

This was Stefan's thinking till the day he heard Romans 12:3 preached in church. He suddenly realised he had all the faith he required for an awesome life and, in fact, could grow his faith.

This same amount of faith is what you've received as God's child. Notice Paul didn't say in our opening scripture: "...a measure of faith"; rather, he used the definite article "the." This shows that there's only one measure of faith, and He gave it to you when you were born again.

You might ask, "If I already got the faith I require, why did Jesus then say in Mark 11:22: 'Have faith in God'?" Or as the marginal reference in some versions puts it, "Have the faith of God." As a new creation, you're born of God's Word, with faith in your spirit. Faith came to you as a seed when you received the Gospel, and it's the same size given to every one of us.

What you're supposed to do is to use it and grow

it. You increase your faith by hearing the Word (Romans 10:17) and make it stronger by acting on the Word. Glory to God!

LET'S TALK



To delight yourself in the Lord means to be excited about God. It means taking joy in serving Him and doing what pleases Him. That was David; he said, *"I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go into the house of the Lord'"* (Psalm 122:1). He loved being in God's presence and pleased God so much that God called him a "...man after My own heart" (Acts 13:22).

To be "excited" means "to be stirred by strong emotion." That means when you think about God, your heart lights up, like when your favourite song plays or you nail something you worked hard on. You want to do anything to make Him happy! That's delighting yourself in the Lord.

The Bible says, *"Then you shall delight yourself in the Lord; and I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth..."* (Isaiah 58:14). Those who delight in God experience life differently, like playing on easy mode while the rest of the world struggles. Every day feels vibrant, full of purpose, and even the miraculous.

Those who aren't excited about Him, even if saved, often have a dull experience of life. But when you delight yourself in the Lord, the Bible says, *"...He shall give you the*

desires of your heart." God places good desires in your heart and fulfils them, so your prayers focus more on others and worship than just asking for yourself.

Get excited about God and all that matters to Him, and watch your life overflow with His goodness and miracles!

LET'S TALK



There's a beautiful confidence that fills your heart when you realise your life isn't a product of chance. Imagine a master conductor leading an orchestra—every instrument comes in at the right time, every note perfectly arranged. In the same way, your life in Christ is divinely orchestrated. Nothing about you is accidental; nothing around you is random.

As Christians, we don't operate by chance, nor do we go anywhere or meet anyone by accident. That means even at school, practice, or hanging out with friends, it's not random or meaningless. If you don't understand this truth, you won't be able to control what happens to you and take possession of what belongs to you. But when you know how God works, and you discover your position in Christ, you'll realise nothing happens to you by accident, chance or coincidence.

The Spirit of God brings divine opportunities, but it's your responsibility to recognise and maximise each one of them. Sometimes those opportunities look like a new friendship, a chance to lead a project, helping someone who feels left out, or making the right choice when others don't. This is the reason you must learn to declare God's Word into your day every morning, before you go out.

Speak peace and productivity to your day, and the Spirit of God will lead you to the right places at the right time! He can guide your conversations, your decisions,

and even your reactions. This is how to operate at the level of the supernatural, where you know nothing will ever happen to you by chance, for God isn't a God of chance. I'm sure you understand now why you need to arm yourself with God's Word.

Tell yourself, "Today, I'm going to walk into divine opportunities. I'm going to put the divinity of God in me to work." Say it confidently, even if you feel nervous or pressured. That means in every situation you find yourself, you're going to recognise the presence of God, and claim for yourself everything good and godly, and refuse to give attention to anything contrary. Even when distractions or peer pressure show up, stay focused on who you are in Christ and choose what honours Him.

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"PROPHECY"

"I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions" (Joel 2:28).

Prophecy has a two-fold application: foretelling and forthtelling. "Foretelling" isn't the same as fortune-telling, palm-reading, star-gazing, crystal-gazing or zodiac sign reading. To foretell, according to the Scriptures, means "to tell ahead of time" things in the mind of God concerning a person or people, places or events.

"Forth-telling," on the other hand, means to speak forth or tell out what's in the mind of God. It's the declaration of a particular word from God to or about an individual, people, place, or event for a particular time...The gift of prophecy is given to any Christian who has the Holy Spirit as the Spirit desires. It's for exhortation, comfort and edification; and it doesn't necessarily have to do with a revelation. The Bible says, *"...you can all prophesy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged"* (1 Corinthians 14:31). Every one of us can prophesy.

Prophecy, therefore, is a word of power spoken to either foretell events or bring forth God's Word into a situation in the now. To operate in the gift of prophecy is to speak words of power, words filled with the ability of God to cause changes and make things happen. When you prophesy, you speak words that affect not just your today but also your future. Your mouth has been fashioned by God as the compass of your life. You need it to arrive at the future of your dreams.



I-TESTIFY

For a long time, I struggled with low energy and frequent sickness. I would get tired easily at school, and it made me feel weak and frustrated. I didn't know what to do until I read the Teevo article about speaking life over your body.

The same way a pupil or student of an institution of learning is expected to attend classes to make good grades, that's how you're expected to show up for school, complete assignments, study for tests, and stay focused if you want to pass your exams or make the team. God expects you to be a student of His Word so you can be successful in life. Success in life isn't dependent on the number of degrees you bagged in college; it's in the amount of God's Word you know and put to work. No demon will listen to you because of your education, nor will sickness, disease, or poverty bow to anything else except the Word of God.

Just as every father desires to see his child progress academically, it's your heavenly Father's desire that you grow up spiritually. Sadly, some Christians are still in the realm of childishness meaning there's still so much in the Word of God to learn. LET'S TALK



There's a touching story about a wealthy man who lived like a pauper, unaware that a vast inheritance had already been credited to his name. He struggled daily, begged for help, and endured needless suffering, not because he lacked resources, but because he lacked knowledge. The tragedy wasn't poverty; it was ignorance.

Sin and the devil aren't as much the problem of many Christians as ignorance is. Jesus dealt with the problem of sin and paralysed the devil, but the only thing standing between some folks and the glorious life is their ignorance of God's Word. That's the reason they suffer. God said, *"My people are destroyed (they experience hardships, defeat, sickness, poverty and all kinds of sufferings) because they lack revelation knowledge"* (Hosea 4:6).

This is the reason, as a Christian, you must let the Word of God dwell in you richly; keep the Word in your heart. If you lack the knowledge of God's Word, you'll live at a level far lower than where Jesus brought us to. Never be too busy to study the Scriptures or attend Church regularly. The Church is the place God has ordained for His children to learn and be built up in the Word. If you want to live the glorious life, you must reject the "luxury" of ignorance and store up God's Word in your heart.

Don't let homework, sports, or scrolling online push

God's Word aside. A few minutes of studying the Scriptures each day can build strength inside you and guide your decisions. Let me illustrate how expensive ignorance is. There was a time malaria was regarded as a mysterious, killer disease. But today the drugs for it are available everywhere. People died back then not because malaria was too powerful, but because the cure was unknown.

In the same way, ignorance can stop you from enjoying the glorious life God has for you. The quality of your life depends on your understanding of His Word. When you store up God's Word in your heart, you'll walk in freedom and reach your highest potential.

The Lord Jesus performed several miracles while He was here on earth; He healed the sick, raised the dead, multiplied food, and turned water into wine—His life was an unending stream of the miraculous. As He prepared to leave the earth, He declared that those who believe in Him would do even greater works than He did. That means He's made you a miracle worker just like Him, even as a teenager in your school, on your team, or in your neighbourhood! He said, *"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father."*

When Peter and John met the crippled man at the gate of the temple, Peter said, *"Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk"* (Acts 3:6). Then Peter grabbed the man's hand and lifted him up and he walked! Peter didn't pray to God to heal the man; Peter performed the miracle in the Name of Jesus! That's the kind of life He's called you to live. Remember the words of the Master: *"... you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you"* (Acts 1:8). LET'S TALK



The Word of God is light (Psalm 119:105), and the Scripture tells us to walk in the light as God is in the light. In other words, we're to walk under the same light in which God dwells and functions. This means we're to walk in the light of God's Word. The people of the world can't understand that light since they're not born into that realm of life. But we can walk in the light and have fellowship with God, because we're born of the Word (1 Peter 1:23).

Walking in the light as God is in the light means your judgments and opinions are based on the light of God's Word. So, instead of forming your opinions from social media trends, peer pressure, or what everyone else thinks is "cool," you choose to see things the way God sees them. Under that light, you don't see poverty, sickness, disease, death, failure or impossibilities. When you agree with what the Word says about you, and then confess it and act that way, you're walking in God's light. God has given you His Word to light up your path, so there wouldn't be darkness or uncertainties as you journey through life.

The Bible lets us know that when you walk in the light, the blood of Jesus Christ automatically cleanses you from

all sin. The world around us is full of sin, and even the very air we breathe is defiled, and God knows it. Then oftentimes, we do things that are wrong without knowing, but thanks be unto God! He says when you walk in the light, you won't need to keep asking yourself, "What sin have I committed today?" The blood of Jesus Christ cleanses you automatically!

Learn to walk in the light as He's in the light. That way, you'll never be weighed down by the burden or yoke of sin; rather, you'll be free to serve God and run the faith race without hindrances.

LET'S TALK



Look at the sky on a rainy day and notice how the clouds gather, heavy with moisture, before any drop falls. Rivers swell, crops grow, and life flourishes, all because the clouds were saturated before the rain came. Just as nature takes its time to prepare for the shower, the changes we seek often require patient preparation.

As a child of God, nothing is impossible with you. No matter how hopeless a situation may look, you can effect a change by consistently speaking God's Word concerning that situation. Some people have found themselves in a situation where they were confessing God's Word to change an unfavourable circumstance, but after a while, they became frustrated and gave up because, from the natural standpoint, nothing seemed to have changed. They even felt more depressed when those around them started asking mockingly, "You've been saying all that stuff from the Bible for weeks; why hasn't anything changed?"

Perhaps you're reading this today, and you're in that situation; you feel like giving up; I have a word of encouragement for you: keep speaking your faith! Don't give up on prayers just because you don't see results yet. The Bible says if the clouds be full of rain, they empty themselves upon the earth (Ecclesiastes 11:3). You have to understand that rain doesn't just fall from the sky; the clouds have to be saturated with moisture. When that happens, you see the

thick, dark rain clouds gathering in the sky. Nobody needs to do anything extra—the rain will pour down naturally.

As it's in the physical, so it is in the spiritual realm. If you hold on just a little longer, the rain of blessings you've been expecting will pour down on you. It may seem like nothing is changing while you're speaking forth the Word of God, but those words are actually working in the spiritual realm. They'll produce results by changing your situation.

So, keep saturating your clouds with your confessions! If someone asks, "Why hasn't anything changed yet?" just smile and say, "I'm still loading up the clouds." In your journey of faith, never give up! When challenges come, go to the Word. Meditate until you receive that personal message (Rhema) from God, and once you do, keep saying it over and over. That Word will grow strong and finally change your situation.

The kings of the earth employ painstaking efforts to raise and culture their children, because they're royalty. Their kids don't walk, talk, dress or behave like everyone else. The expectations are even greater when the child in question is the heir-apparent. That's why Solomon said, *"I was my father's son, tender and the only one in the sight of my mother. He also taught me, and said to me: 'Let your heart retain my words; keep my commands, and live'"* (Proverbs 4:3-4).

Solomon certainly wasn't David's only child, yet he said, "I was my father's son" because he was the one groomed for the throne. There was a special training David needed to bequeath to him, which the other sons didn't get. As God's children, we're His heirs: *"and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ..."* (Romans 8:17). You're a joint-heir with Jesus Christ!

You're not an ordinary person; you're a prince of power with God. Your heavenly Father owns the whole world and has placed you in charge of His possessions. No wonder the Bible says all things are yours (1 Corinthians 3:21). What an honour to be an heir of God! You've been called to reign in

life as a king. Make up your mind to walk, talk and live as a king that you are.

Refuse to use beggarly language; the children of kings don't talk cheap; they exercise authority. In your prayers, don't beg. Relate with God as a son. He loves you and knows you're His heir, who has a right to His inexhaustible inheritance. Glory to God!

LET'S TALK



Christianity isn't a religion; it's the pulsating life of God in a human person. When you become a Christian, it means eternal life has been imparted to your spirit. You become God's dwelling place. So, now that you're born again, God has fully tabernacled in you! You've become His living headquarters. He looks through your eyes and walks with your legs. You're a God-carrying vessel.

Talking about Jesus, the Bible says *"...in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; and you are complete in Him..."* (Colossians 2:9-10). Notice the tenth verse says *"And you are complete in Him..."* In other words, all of divinity resides in you. You've become God's operating centre! You're loaded with the maximum load of God. That's what it means to be "complete in Him," as rendered in the original Greek text. Nothing else needs to be done in you to make you as divine as God is divine, because He already lives in you in His fullness.

This is why sickness, diseases, and infirmities shouldn't be part of your life. You have in you the genes of your heavenly Father. You're as divine as God is divine. Basically, God's power isn't just for church or Sunday; it's

running through you all the time, even when you're at school or hanging out with friends. You're sufficient in His sufficiency (2 Corinthians 3:5); in other words, His abilities are at work in you. No wonder the Bible declares that you're a partaker of His divine nature (2 Peter 1:4). Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE - Romans 8:28

"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."

LET'S TALK



Have you ever felt like life is totally unfair? Like, no matter what you do, things just keep going wrong? Maybe friends have let you down, school is tough, or your dreams feel so far away. That's what we're discussing today.

If you ever find yourself in a difficult situation where things look bleak, don't despair; rather, rejoice, because that seemingly negative situation is part of the grand process for your promotion. Joseph's brothers sold him as a slave in Egypt (Genesis 37:28), but from prison, Joseph rose to become the Prime Minister of Egypt. No wonder the Bible says, *"count it all joy when you fall into various trials"* (James 1:2), because the result is certain: they'll turn out for your good!

Think about this: everything around you—your friends, your school, even social media—can somehow work in your favour when you trust God. Just like the stars in their courses fought for Deborah against her enemies (Judges 5:20), the things in your world can line up to help you win. Even in moments that feel totally out of your control, God has your back. Remember Joshua commanding the sun and moon to stand still (Joshua 10:12-14)? God made creation

work for Joshua's advantage. In the same way, God is setting things up in your life, even the stuff that seems random or frustrating, to make sure you win.

God has ordained your life, so no challenge can truly overwhelm you. When trials and pressures come, face them with the mindset of someone who already has the advantage. Praise God!

Job was a man who had lived in great affluence because he was richly blessed of God. But imagine the terrible words he uttered when he got into trouble! This is just like some folks; when they face even a small problem—like failing a test or dealing with family drama—they forget so quickly all the good things God has done for them. Not only do they wallow in self-pity, but they also want everyone to feel sorry for them.

If you read the whole chapter, it's full of lamentation and self-pity. This is the result of fear and a lack of understanding of the nature of God. Job wished to die. He had given up. But the Lord was merciful and restored him. We must learn not to give up in times of adversity.

The man of faith is the man with a righteous heart that's fixed on God and trusting in Him. He doesn't accept defeat and refuses to give in. He doesn't give consideration to anything aside God's Word. He lives a consistent and persistent life of confession of the Word. People without faith complain about everything and focus on the negatives. Job opened his mouth and cursed his day. Christians, full of

faith, however, open their mouths to encourage themselves and others, speaking God's Word even when things seem tough.

Faith that possesses doesn't speak carelessly. Therefore, no matter what the case may be, let the life you live be the life of faith. When school, friendships, or personal challenges try to knock you down, refuse to cower or give up; keep speaking God's Word over your life, because faith always wins. Glory to God!
