1 Timothy 2:1

I'm guided by God's Wisdom everyday as I serve with humility, loving the Lord in everything I do.




Speak The Right Words

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer.






Don't Complain; Speak!

Scripture Reading-1 Peter 2:9


The Creator of the heavens and the earth is my Father. Therefore, I'm special and precious. Hallelujah!

What You Need To Know About Prophecy - Part 1.

In this edition of Titbits, we shall begin a new series on "What You Need To Know." I know you're already eager to learn something new. We'll look at what prophecy really is and its importance to you as a Christian. Let's get started.

WHAT IS PROPHECY? - Romans 9:8; 1 Corinthians 14:29-31.

As a Christian, you're a child of prophecy. This means that you were born, built, and blessed by prophecy. But still, a lot of people don't understand what prophecy really is.

When I say you're a child of prophecy, it's the same as saying you're a child of promise. In Romans 9:8 the



word "Promise" refers to God's Word.

The Prophecy I'm talking about is the prophecy of the Word, and it has a two-fold use: foretelling and forth-telling.

"Foretelling" means to tell ahead of time things in the mind of God concerning a person or people, places or events.

"Forth-telling," on the other hand, means to speak forth, tell out or tell forward what's in the mind of God. It's the declaration of a particular Word from God to an individual, people, place, or event for a particular time.

Prophecy, therefore, is in two classes. The first category is the ministry of a prophet, while the other is the use of the gift of prophecy, which is given to any Christian who is filled with the Holy Spirit.


