LET'S TALK



In many nations of the world today, Christians face severe persecution daily. In some cities, talking about Jesus can even lead to jail time or having churches shut down. Because of this, some churches are hesitant to speak out boldly, often choosing their words carefully to avoid offending local authorities. No; as long as you're proclaiming the truth of God's Word, be bold. Don't keep quiet. Declare boldly before anyone the truth that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, meaning God in the flesh. He's the way, the truth, and the life, and no one can come into a relationship with God except by Him (John 14:6).

You might say, "But my country's laws prohibit such statements." Remember, Jesus Christ is the ultimate authority. He rules over heaven, earth, and everything beneath. His authority surpasses any earthly law or government. So, who would you rather obey? The authorities in your country are subject to Him. The Bible tells us Jesus holds the highest honour in Heaven—far above any human authority. He bears a Name that's far beyond any name that could ever be used in this world or the world to come. Daniel once told King Nebuchadnezzar that he needed to recognise that

"Heaven rules" (Daniel 4:26 NIV). Even the greatest king of his time had to learn that God's rule is supreme.

Don't think the mayor of your city or the president of your country is the one ruling; you represent Heaven, and Heaven rules.

LET'S TALK



"I'm not sure I'm cut out for this; I just can't seem to understand the Bible whenever I read it," Sylvia sighed in frustration.

"No, Sylvia, don't say that. You're a child of God; therefore, you have the ability to understand the scriptures," Emily reminded her.

As a child of God, it's your divine right and ability to understand the Scriptures. Never agree with those who claim the Bible is difficult to understand. It's one of Satan's strategies to deceive God's people and try to make them believe they can't understand the Scriptures. Never agree with it; you have the understanding of the righteous.

The Bible tells us that God has given us a sound mind. The power is in accepting and declaring what God has said. So even if you've been having difficulties with your understanding of the Word, right now, say, I'm sound; my mind is sound. I'm alert. I have good understanding." Don't accept the devil's lies that God's Word is mysterious. Accept that you have an understanding mind.

Part of the ministry of the Holy Spirit in your life is to help you understand the Scriptures. In John 14:26, Jesus said, *"But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost,*

whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." The Bible also tells us how He breathed on His disciples and said, "Receive ye the Holy Ghost" (John 20:22), thus opening their minds to understand the Scriptures (Luke 24:45). After the meeting, Naomi approached Ben and asked, “How are we going to pay for the venue? What we’ve received so far isn’t even up to half of what we require.”

“Naomi, you’ve got to see with the eyes of faith. We have all the money we require, and we’ll pay for the hall,” Ben responded.

In our opening scripture, God was giving Abraham a very important training on how to see with the eyes of faith. The Lord brought him out at night and told him to count the stars in the sky. Of course, there were too many. While still trying to count, God said to him, “So shall thy seed be.” Abraham believed, and that was the moment he got it. God trained him to use his spiritual sense of sight.

On another occasion, after Lot had separated from him, God told him to look from where he was to the east, west, north, and south, and said everything Abraham saw would be given to him and his seed (Genesis 13:14–

15). By this time, Abraham had understood how to use his spiritual sense of sight. Upon God's instruction, the Bible says Abraham saw the whole world, and God gave it to him. Just like Abraham, you have to practice seeing with your spirit.

You have to have times when you just sit down and use your spiritual sight. What you see in those moments is what you get. If it's the wrong picture, shake it off and reject it! And then change your mind, change your thoughts, and change the words that are coming to you. Realign yourself, refocus, and look again; the right pictures will come. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE: HEBREWS 1:14 NKJV

“Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?”

LET'S TALK



There's a difference between how angels interacted with people in the Old Testament and how they interact with us now in the New Testament. In the Old Testament, angels had authority over people, even to the point of punishing those who did wrong.

A simple example is the story of Zechariah. Although it's found in what is generally indicated as “The New Testament” in most Bibles, it actually happened in the Old Testament. The archangel Gabriel brought Zechariah the news that he and his wife would have a child in their old age. When Zechariah doubted the message, Gabriel punished him by making him dumb until John the Baptist was born! (see Luke 1:19–20).

But things changed in the New Testament. Now, angels are our servants! The Bible says in Hebrews 1:14, *“Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?”* We are the heirs of salvation.

In the Old Testament, angels ministered to people. But in the New Testament, they minister for us saints—that is, they work on our behalf. This is amazing! It shows how real and powerful our connection with the Lord Jesus is because we operate in His Name. In His Name, we can give

instructions, and angels will obey. The Bible says in 1 Peter 3:22: *“Who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject to Him.”*

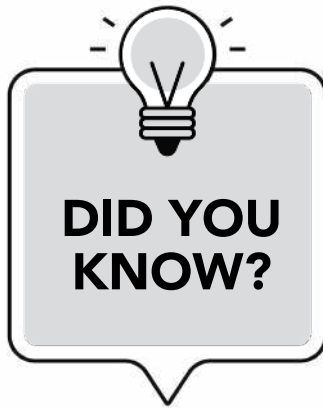

FACTS ABOUT LANGUAGES

Language is a remarkable human creation that connects people across cultures, time, and geography, enabling us to share ideas, express identities, and document history. With over 7,000 languages worldwide, each reflects unique perspectives and cognitive frameworks. Language evolves alongside its speakers, adapting to social and technological changes, yet nearly 40% are endangered in our globalized world. This diversity of languages showcases the depth of human ingenuity, revealing distinct ways of thinking, feeling, and understanding the world. Here are some amazing facts about languages;

1. Most Spoken Language: Mandarin Chinese is the most spoken language in the world, with over a billion native speakers. This makes it the native language of roughly one in seven people globally.
2. Oldest Known Written Language: Sumerian, written in cuneiform script, is one of the oldest known written languages, dating back to around 3,000 BCE in Mesopotamia.
3. Most Words in a Language: English is estimated to have the largest vocabulary of any language, with over a million words due to its history of borrowing from many languages.
4. The Complexity of Finnish: Finnish is known for its complex grammar, including 15 different grammatical cases, which influence how nouns, pronouns, and adjectives function in sentences.
5. The Whistling Language of La Gomera: On the Canary Island of La Gomera, the Silbo Gomero language uses whistling to

communicate across long distances, with each whistled tone representing syllables.

6. The Most Translated Document: The Universal Declaration of Human Rights holds the record for being the most translated document, available in over 500 languages.

7. The Language with No Words for Numbers: The Pirahã language, spoken by an indigenous tribe in Brazil, has no words for specific numbers, only terms for “few” and “many.”

8. Languages on the Verge of Extinction: Around 40% of the world’s languages are endangered, with many only spoken by a handful of people. It’s estimated that we lose a language every two weeks.

9. Click Languages of Africa: Some African languages, such as Xhosa and !Kung, use click sounds as part of their phonetic inventory, making them quite unique to the ear.

10. Longest Alphabet: The Khmer language, spoken in Cambodia, has the world’s longest alphabet, with 74 letters.

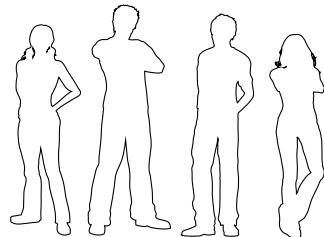
11. Language without Time: The Amondawa people in the Amazon have no concept of linear time in their language—no words for “past” or “future,” nor any calendar terms.

12. Official Languages of India: India has no national language, but it recognizes 22 official languages at the national level, reflecting its cultural and linguistic diversity.

13. Gendered Words in Grammatical Structures: In languages like German, French, and Spanish, all nouns have a gender, which often affects adjectives, articles, and sometimes verbs.

14. Sign Language Diversity: Just like spoken languages, sign languages vary by region and culture. American Sign Language (ASL) and British Sign Language (BSL) are distinct languages with different gestures.

15. Shortest Alphabet: The Rotokas language, spoken on Bougainville Island in Papua New Guinea, has only 12 letters, making it one of the simplest alphabets in use.

It makes no difference what pressures and obstacles you face in life; what's important is that the Lord is with you and in you. He's your peace in the midst of the storm. Is there a situation that has made you fretful or given you sleepless nights? Relax, Jesus is your peace. He said in John 16:33, *"These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me you have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world."* Can you see why, just like Jane, you should never be flustered by

the adversary or any adversity that comes your way? The Lord already gave you victory and dominion over Satan and everything he's capable of.

"What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?"

LET'S TALK



In the Old Testament, the Israelites carried the presence of God with them by transporting the Tabernacle of Witness, which contained the Ark of the Covenant. The Bible tells us in 1 Kings 8:9 that *"There was nothing in the ark except the two stone tablets that Moses had put there at Horeb (Sinai), where the Lord made a covenant with the Israelites when they came out of the land of Egypt."* These stone tablets held God's commandments.

Today, your heart is the new ark of God—it's where His Word lives. In Jeremiah 31:33 NKJV, God said, "But this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they shall be My people." This promise was fulfilled in us when we were born again. We were born again by the Word of God and have become one with it. Now, we are living letters from God, *"written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart."* (2 Corinthians 3:3 NKJV).

You are now the living ark of testimony and the dwelling place of God's presence. The Bible says in 2 Corinthians 6:16 NIV, "For you are the temple of the living God; as God has said: 'I will dwell in them and walk among

them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people.”

He dwells in you now. His hands are in your hands, and His legs are in your legs. He walks in you and talks through you. Wherever you go, God goes. You’re not just in His presence; you carry His presence.

"Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

LET'S TALK

The word "helpeth" in our opening verse comes from the Greek word "synantilambanomai," which is a complex term meaning "to strive together with" or "to take hold of something together, against an opposing force." This gives us a clear picture of what intercession is all about and how God expects us to engage in it.

For example, if I join forces with you against someone, it means we're on the same side. In intercession, God teams up with us against the enemy. So, when Paul wrote, "The Spirit also helpeth our infirmities," he was letting us know that the Holy Spirit partners with us in prayer against the enemy, especially when we're praying for those who are unable to help themselves. The word "infirmities" comes from the Greek word "Astheneia," which refers to a form of weakness or limitation—when someone lacks the strength or ability they need.

Imagine someone who's been seriously ill for a long time and is now too weak to claim the healing and health that Christ has already provided. Who's holding them back? Satan. But God wants to heal them. So, the Holy Spirit comes alongside us to pray for that person. We stand in the

gap for them, and together with the Holy Spirit, we rebuke the enemy. This means the Holy Spirit is an intercessor, and He carries out this ministry through us. It also means He's not the one causing the problem or holding anything back. He's on our side, helping us.

If you've been praying for a friend or a family member to come to Christ, remember there's no need to try and convince God to save them. The Holy Spirit is already on your side, praying with you against the enemy who's blinding their mind from receiving God's truth. Take full advantage of this incredible partnership with the Holy Spirit today.

Isn’t it amazing what we just read in our opening verse? How I wish every young Christian in the world would grasp the depth of this truth; it’ll make champions out of them! Consider what we just read again; it says the Holy Spirit quickens—vitalises—your mortal body. He gives life to your body. That means there shouldn’t be death in any part of your body because the Spirit of life lives in you. Hallelujah!

God wants you to be bold and unafraid of death. Be like Paul who was unperturbed when he was bitten by a poisonous snake. Those around him were waiting for him to fall down and die, but he just calmly shook the snake into the fire. This was what he knew; he was conscious that nothing could hurt or harm the one in whom the Holy Ghost dwelt.

Now that you’re born again, you’ve been transferred from humanity to eternity, which means you’ve become incorruptible, indestructible, and imperishable. You’re not subject to failure, defeat, and death! This should be your consciousness—a consciousness of life in and by the Spirit! Praise God forevermore!

The Bible records in Genesis 6:1-4 how beings described as "sons of God" intermingled with humans: "...the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose" (Genesis 6:2). "Sons of God" as used in this context were angels who had left their calling and estate and used their bodies for evil things; they mated with humans and produced giant offsprings. Jude, by the Spirit, revealed what eventually happened to these angels: *"And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day"* (Jude 1:6).

God imprisoned these angels to stop their wickedness. However, their offspring—giants with insatiable appetites and a tendency for extreme evil—roamed the earth. They built cities and consumed vegetation at an alarming rate, such that it took a lot to sustain them. When these giants died, their spirits, being demons, went to hell. However, these demons weren't permanently confined to hell; they moved in and out as they chose, causing chaos on earth.

Our world today is stilled faced with these wicked spirits—demons influencing human affairs and fomenting

evil. But we have the authority in the Name of Jesus to overcome them. So use His Name today to break their influence over your environment, city, and nation. Cast them out in the Name of Jesus! When you do, the hearts of many in those regions will open to the Gospel, and righteousness will prevail. Hallelujah!

"Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath."

LET'S TALK



Have you ever seen a young child throwing a tantrum? Sadly, some of them make a habit of it and carry that unchecked anger into adulthood. It's important to recognize and overcome uncontrolled anger that might have started when you were young. Think about the story of Moses in Numbers 20. When the Israelites were thirsty in the wilderness, they complained to Moses. God told Moses to speak to the rock, and water would come out (Numbers 20:8). But instead of speaking to the rock as God instructed, Moses, frustrated by the people's complaints, struck the rock in anger.

The result? Water came out and the people drank, but the consequence against Moses was severe. God told him he wouldn't lead the people into the Promised Land (Numbers 20:12). Moses let his anger control him, and it cost him dearly. James 1:20 NIV reminds us, *"Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires."* Your anger won't bring about God's best; it will likely lead you to do things contrary to God's will, and sometimes it might be too late before you realize it.

So, how do you deal with anger? Conquer it with

God's Word. Ephesians 4:26–27 (TLB) says, "If you are angry, don't sin by nursing your grudge. Don't let the sun go down with you still angry—get over it quickly; for when you are angry, you give a mighty foothold to the devil."

LET'S TALK

If you're responsible for leading other young people in church, you may sometimes find yourself worried that some of them aren't living right. Well, I've got the solution for you—keep teaching them God's Word, and they'll be transformed! There's no better way to purify God's people than by sharing His Word with them.

Notice what we read in our opening verse: the Lord Jesus said, "You're clean through the Word that I have spoken unto you. The Word has that sanctifying power. The Bible says, *"Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word"* (Ephesians 5:25–26). When the true Word of God is taught, people will always come to hear that message that purifies, empowers, and inspires them. It will even propel them to become soul winners, for the Word makes them fishers of men, as He did the early disciples.

The Lord chose David above all his family members, yet David had nothing to do with it. God hasn't changed; He still chooses to favour people today, and He's chosen to favour you! Not only is it God's choice, it's also His set time to favour you. Believe this. Paul, writing to Timothy, said, *"Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus"* (2 Timothy 2:1).

That's what you ought to do: take advantage of the grace that's in Christ Jesus. He likes you, and He's favourably disposed towards you; be conscious of this. There's grace for you from God for whatever you require right now: *"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work"* (2 Corinthians 9:8).

LET'S TALK



Our opening verse tells us something striking about God's Kingdom that we're a part of: it's a Kingdom with glory and power! Let's focus on the word "glory." The Bible says God's people will speak of His glory and make known the glorious majesty of His Kingdom. But what exactly does "glory" mean?

Glory is what inspires admiration, respect, and honor. When something happens that makes you want to praise and honour someone, that event is considered glorious. So, when we say a meeting was glorious, it means people were moved to worship and praise God. The experience led them to honour Him. For example, when Jesus turned water into wine at a wedding, the Bible says, *"This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth His glory; and His disciples believed on Him"* (John 2:11). The miracle amazed everyone and showed His glory, leading His disciples to believe in Him and honor Him.

Now, when the Bible says, *"They shall speak of the glory of your Kingdom..."* (Psalm 145:11), it's talking about

the incredible things in God's Kingdom. It's a place where sickness doesn't exist, defeat is impossible, and life and immortality reign!

This is the Kingdom we're born into as Christians. 1 Peter 2:9 (AMPC) says, *"But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, [God's] own purchased, special people, that you may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of Him Who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."* When you live in the light of who you are in Christ, you showcase the glory of God's Kingdom. Hallelujah!

Isn't it wonderful to know that even if your parents didn't leave you any inheritance, Jesus gave you one? You're the seed of Abraham, and the whole world belongs to you. Only a Christian who's ignorant of this will live a beggarly life. It's like someone who goes to an event with an all-access ticket yet stops at the gate to plead with the organisers to be allowed in. With your ticket, you don't need to beg; just walk in and enjoy the party! It's all about the ticket.

Jesus is your ticket to a boundless inheritance. The Amplified Classic describes it as unsearchable riches—wealth untold which no human being can search out (Ephesians 3:8). He qualified you for the inheritance. Part of that inheritance is sound health. The Bible says, *"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth"* (3 John 1:2). He wants you to prosper financially and be healthy enough to enjoy your wealth. How wonderful that is!

Then He said in John 16:23, *"Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you."* In other

words, not only did He qualify you to be a partaker of His glorious inheritance, He's saying, "Use my name!" That's your ticket to enjoy all that's been granted you in Christ. Praise God!

LET'S TALK



Last Sunday, Pastor Charles preached a powerful message about "The Wages of Sin and the Gift of God" and when he made the altar call, Jake promptly stood up to pray the Prayer of Salvation. But this was exactly what happened two Sundays ago, and the Sunday before that! Jake was always giving his heart to Christ.

There are young Christians like Jake who are always getting born again or re-dedicating their lives to Christ? Well, that's because they're sin-conscious. Think about what we just read in our opening scripture; it says to walk in the light as He—our Lord Jesus—is in the light, and as you do, His blood cleanses you from all sin. Notice it doesn't say you should pray for the blood of Jesus Christ to cleanse you from sin. No; the cleansing is automatic! It happens without you asking!

Remember, the Lord Jesus said, "*Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you*" (John 15:3). Why is this important? It's because there's so much decay in the world around us, and just by being in contact with it, we're sometimes smeared by that mess. However, by walking in the light, all your errors, mistakes, and missteps that you didn't even know about are cleansed. So be sure

that you're walking in His light, and His light is His Word.

See yourself under God's light. If you've been born again and you still find yourself praying the prayer of salvation every week, that's because you're looking at yourself under a different light that's showing you something is wrong. But God's light shows that you're the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. See yourself thus and walk accordingly. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE 1 JOHN 2:1

"And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous."

LET'S TALK



Some people think that since Jesus went to heaven, He's been pleading with the Father to forgive our sins. But that's absolutely absurd. If Jesus had to come and die for our sins, why would He still be begging God to forgive us? Jesus Christ is our advocate, but with the Father. He's our advocate on the Father's side. He's not bringing arguments to the Father to convince Him not to punish us. No! He's the Father's lawyer, appointed by Him on our behalf!

He's the one who helps us insist on what belongs to us. He sees to it that we walk in the vital reality of all that His death, burial, and resurrection consummated for us. Think of it like this: If someone is accusing you of something and your dad hires the best lawyer to represent you, that lawyer's job isn't to convince your dad not to be upset. Your dad isn't the one accusing you; he's supporting you. Jesus Christ is that lawyer; He's not defending you from the Father's wrath, for God isn't your accuser. In Revelation 12:10, it's clear that the devil is the accuser. But God has given us Jesus as our advocate. And there's even more! The Holy Spirit is also our advocate here on earth. The Lord Jesus said in John 14:16 that He would ask God to send us another Comforter, which means Advocate.

The Holy Spirit is your advocate or counsel for the defense. He doesn't just watch from the background as we grapple with forces and circumstances that assail us; He comes right into the middle of the heat and takes charge with us. He engages our adversaries.

Never forget this: Jesus is our advocate with the Father, while the Holy Spirit is the Father's advocate with us. So, there's one advocate in heaven, and there's another one here on earth, in us and with us. How could we lose or ever be disadvantaged? It's impossible!

LET'S TALK



When you read this epistle of John, you have to be careful to read everything; otherwise, you may conclude that there are contradictions. For example, in our opening verse, the epistle says, "It doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is." This, therefore, means we're not yet like Him.

But then 1 John 4:17 says, "As He is, so are we in this world." At first glance, this might seem like a contradiction. How can we be like Jesus now if we're not like Him yet? The first one is about your appearance—your outward appearance. Look at it again, "Beloved, now are we the sons of God." We're already the sons of God in our spirits. The Bible says, "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17). That recreation took place in your spirit when you were born again. Now, your spirit is like Him, but your physical appearance isn't like Him yet. So when it says, "It doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is," he's referring to the

Rapture, where, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, we shall be changed. We will be clothed with our celestial bodies, and we shall be like Him in appearance. Glory to God!

Observe that 1 John 4:17 says, "*as He is...*" not "*as He was.*" We're like Him now, not as He was before His death. When He was raised from the dead, we were raised together with Him, and we came alive with a new kind of life: the resurrection life. So, as He is now, the glorified Son of God, so are we in this world!

"And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many" (Matthew 24:11).

"And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus" (Acts 13:6)

Matthew 24:11 warns of false prophets deceiving many. Traditionally, this might seem to refer to misleading religious figures. However, Acts 13:6 speaks of Bar-Jesus, a "false prophet" who is also termed a "sorcerer" (magos), a Greek word for an oriental scientist or wise man. This term historically referred to astrologers and diviners, not just religious deceivers. False prophets are not just deceitful religious leaders but are pseudo-scientists and sorcerers.

In today's world, this might mean individuals who, despite their scientific credentials, use their expertise to spread misleading or false information. For example, some people might make exaggerated claims about scientific breakthroughs or project future scenarios that aren't based on solid evidence, all to sway public opinion or benefit themselves.

For young people navigating today's world, it's important to think critically and question claims made by those who seem to have all the answers. By staying alert and asking the right questions, you protect yourselves from being misled and make better decisions based on real, trustworthy information.

Consider what we just read in our opening verse. I would to God that all young Christians around would come to the knowledge of this; many wouldn't have to grope in the dark trying to figure out life. As God's children, we're never in the dark about anything. You can know anything because the light of God is in your spirit. If you ever find yourself in a situation where it seems you're at a loss for answers concerning a situation, speak in tongues.

As you speak in tongues, the mystery about that situation will come to your understanding. If you have concerns about your health, don't rush to doctors or seek help everywhere. First, talk to the Holy Spirit. You'll be surprised at how quickly His wisdom will come to you, guiding you on what steps to take.

He's in you to help you understand certain things about yourself and about life. He'll show you the future and guide you to take specific steps in line with His plans for your life. John 16:13 says, *"Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come."* Learn to follow His light and guidance from within you.

"I thought He died for Christians?", Daniella answered 'No; it was for the whole world!', "Did you know that God isn't counting the sins of men against them? He isn't because Jesus already died for everybody". 2 Corinthians 5:19 NIV says, "*that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.*" Observe that it says God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself. Why? It's because Jesus paid for everybody. When Jesus died, every one of us died in Him; in the mind of justice, we were in Him in His death. When God raised Him up, the whole world was given the opportunity to receive eternal life. That's the reason our message is His Gospel to the whole world. Our mission is to tell the whole world that Jesus paid for their salvation; therefore, they don't have to die or be judged anymore. For everyone in the world today

who hasn't been born again, eternal life is available now. All they have to do is believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead in His substitutionary act of salvation, confess the Lordship of Jesus over their lives, and they'll be brought into the vital realization, experience and union with the living Christ. Hallelujah!

Liam worried a lot about the future, and most importantly how his parents were going to make payments for a new school session. But the Bible says in 2 Corinthians 9:8 AMPC: *"And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]."* Our God is so gracious and kind. Did you know that He has more than enough supply for you every day? He isn't just into 'provision'; He's into abundant supply. Hallelujah!

Think about how you've been in a state of constant supply, it's because He wants you to have, not only for yourself, but enough to help others. LET'S TALK



If you claim to be living unto the Lord, but still harbour hurt, offence, or anger, it raises the question of whether your desire to please the Lord is genuine. In other words, your displeasure can only be a reflection of His displeasure, which means you'll take nothing personally; you become impervious to personal offences.

In life, many grapple with discontentment, burdened by various concerns and life's challenges. Often, their dissatisfaction stems from not having learnt the value and fulfilment of living unto Christ. Living unto Him means finding contentment and fulfilment in what pleases Him, and your displeasure is confined to that which also displeases Him.

It brings to mind the story in 1 Samuel 8:4-7; the elders of Israel approached the prophet Samuel at Ramah, expressing their desire for a king to rule over them like other nations. Samuel, displeased by their request, prayed to the Lord. God responded, instructing Samuel to heed the people's voice, clarifying that their request was a rejection of Him as their King rather than a rejection of Samuel.

The prophet Samuel felt personally offended, but

God corrected and taught him a great lesson about being impervious to hurts, as it was about Him, not Samuel. Living for the Lord involves transcending personal feelings and aligning yourself with His divine will.

TO THE BIBLE Acts 1:8

"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth"

LET'S TALK



In Acts 1:8, the Lord Jesus told His disciples they would receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon them, and that power would make them effective witnesses. The word "power" in this context means power that works! The Greek rendering is "Dunamis"; it signifies inherent power—power that reproduces itself; it's the root word from which we get the English, 'dynamo.'

A dynamo is a device that generates electrical power through the conversion of mechanical energy. So, the term dynamo is often used to describe a generator that continuously generates power without requiring external assistance. This is the kind of power at work in you today. It's a miracle-working ability.

This power makes you an effective witness to your world. A witness is one who possesses evidence and proof; he's one who's called to testify of what he knows. So, should you ever feel weak as a witness, activate the power within you! Paul explains how to do this in Ephesians 5:18-20; it's by getting yourself drunk in the Holy Ghost!

Also, in 1 Corinthians 14:4, the Bible says, "He that

speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself...." In other words, when you speak in tongues, you activate the power within you and make it effectual, if it had been lying dormant. It's the power that works; with it, you can produce anything.

TO THE BIBLE *Colossians 2:9 AMPC*

For in Him the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature].

LET'S TALK

One of the many distinct differences between Jesus and the Old Testament prophets was that Jesus had all of God's power living in Him all the time. The prophets only had the Holy Spirit show up and work through them every now and then. For example, we read the story in Judges 6 when Gideon was chosen by God to deliver Israel from the Midianites. The Bible says, "But the Spirit of the LORD came upon Gideon, and he blew a trumpet; and Abiezer was gathered after him" (Judges 6:34).

Also, in the 14th chapter, we find the story of Samson who encountered a young lion while on his way to Timnath. The Spirit of the Lord came upon him, enabling him to tear the lion apart "as he would have torn a kid" (Judges 14:6).

In 1 Samuel 10:10, before Saul became king, the Spirit of the Lord came upon him, and he prophesied among the prophets. Also, read the story of David in 1 Samuel 16:13. After Samuel anointed David as the future king of Israel, the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him. But today, the dynamics have changed. We're in the generation of Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit doesn't come on us like He did with those in the Old Testament. He lives in us now in His fullness.

The Holy Spirit lives in you in His maximum capacity

and entirety, just like Paul said about Jesus in Colossians 1:19, "For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell." In the next chapter, Paul also reiterated, "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily" (Colossians 2:9). Then in the very next verse, He was quick to add that we are complete in Him: "And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power" (Colossians 2:10). So, today, just like Jesus, when you walk the streets, it's with the fullness of the Godhead. God Almighty, in His fullness, lives, walks and talks in you. Hallelujah! Can you see that you aren't an ordinary person? You're a God-carrying vessel, filled with His fulness, and doing extraordinary things. Glory to God!

TO THE BIBLE *Matthew 13:44 TLB*

"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure a man discovered in a field. In his excitement, he sold everything he owned to get enough money to buy the field—and get the treasure, too!"

LET'S TALK

The Lord Jesus vividly describes the Kingdom of Heaven as a 1 hidden treasure in a field. The field symbolizes the world, and the treasure within it is the Church. Jesus saw the Church in the visions of His Spirit. He, in turn, paid the ultimate price, shedding His own blood to legally acquire the whole world for the sake of the treasure therein.

Thus, the world belongs to Jesus; He is its rightful owner. Hebrews 1:2 AMPC emphatically declares that Jesus Christ is not just an appointed heir, but He's the lawful owner of all things: "[But] in the last of these days He has spoken to us in [the person of a] Son, Whom He appointed Heir and lawful Owner of all things..."

Then in Romans 8:16-17, we learn that as children of God, we're joint-heirs with Christ. This implies that everything that belongs to Jesus belongs to the Church in the same way that it belongs to Him. Therefore, as He is—the lawful owner of all things—so are we. He doesn't own it without us, and we don't own it without Him. We have equal rights to everything that the Father gave to Jesus.

Ephesians 3:8 (AMPC) describes our wealth and inheritance as boundless, fathomless, incalculable and

exhaustless. Hallelujah! Have this consciousness. Walk through life with the mentality that the whole world belongs to you, because it does in Christ Jesus.

The whole world was willed to Abraham, but the promise had to be fulfilled in Christ. The Bible says, *“And if ye be Christ’s, then are ye Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise”* (Galatians 3:29). The whole earth is ours; we’re not trying to get it; it belongs to us in Christ. Now you can understand why the Bible says in 1 Corinthians 3:21-22, *“Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours; Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world... all are yours.”* Blessed be God!

LET'S TALK



One of the most beautiful things about Christianity is the blessing of using the Name of Jesus. When you speak or proclaim healing for the sick in His Name, your words are effective, producing exactly what they talk about. Did you know that when it comes to healing the sick, we're the ones God asked to do it? He gave us power to heal. In our theme scripture, the Lord Jesus didn't say the believing ones shall pray to me to heal the sick; rather, He said, they shall lay hands on the sick, and the sick shall be healed. Then in Luke 10:9, He was just as direct when He sent His disciples out to preach the Gospel. He said, "heal the sick...and say unto them, the kingdom of God is come nigh unto you." Also, He told them, *"And as ye go, preach, saying, the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give"* (Matthew 10:7-8). In Acts 3:16, he further emphasized the power of the Name of Jesus when he said that faith in His Name had made the formerly lame man strong: "And his name through faith in his name hath

made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.”

Now go ahead and make declarations in His Name about your health and that of your loved ones. Proclaim healing for many today who are sick and in hospitals. Hallelujah!

LET'S TALK

The Bible tells us about Joseph who was brought into the house of Potiphar as a slave. However, because the Lord was with him, everything he did prospered. 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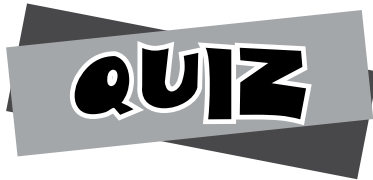
