

Hallelujah!






Your Great Teacher


As God's child, the same grace is at work in you. You have divine abilities to produce excellent results at all times. This means you've got the ability to be the best in your studies and



Precious Father, I thank you for my life that you've made for beauty, glory and honour; therefore, I walk in your perfect will, in Jesus' Name, Amen.






Do The Right Thing The First Time


